

GAME NOTES



San Francisco 49ers at Cincinnati Bengals Sunday, September 15, 2019

With the win...

- The **Niners** open the season with back-to-back road wins for the first time since the 1989 season.
- The **49ers** have won road games in consecutive weeks for the first time since Weeks 13-14 of the 2017 season [W, 15-14 at Chi. (12/3/17) & W, 26-16 at Hou. (12/10/17)].
- **San Francisco** begins the season 2-0 for the first time since the 2012 season and the 19th time in franchise history.
- The **49ers** improved to 12-4 overall against the Bengals, including a 5-2 record on the road.

Points, Points Baby

- After defeating the Bengals, 41-17 at Cin., the **49ers** won on the road by 24-or-more pts. for the first time since 10/27/13 at Jax. (W, 42-10).
- San Francisco's 41 pts. scored are the most by the team since 12/24/17 vs. Jax. (44 pts.) and the most scored on the road by the 49ers since 10/27/13 at Jax. (42 pts.).

On A Per-Play Basis

- **San Francisco** finished averaging 8.41 yds. per play, the most by the team since 11/6/16 vs. NO (8.53 yds. per play).

Rush Hour

- The **49ers offense** rushed for 259 yds. on the day, the most by the team since 12/20/14 vs. SD (355 rushing yds.). It also marks the most rushing yds. by the team on the road since 11/29/10 at Arz. (261 rushing yds.).
- San Francisco registered 13 rushing 1st downs, the most in a single game by the team since 9/14/15 vs. Min. (14 rushing 1st downs).

Elite Yards

- The **49ers offense** finished with 572 total net yds. of offense, the most by the team since 10/7/12 vs. Buf. (621 total net yds.) and the 5th-most in franchise history.

Third Of The Way Through

- Through the first 3 Qtrs., the **49ers offense** registered 513 total net yds. of offense, the most by the team in Qtrs. 1-3 since 10/18/92 vs. Atl. (540 total net yds.).

Sling The Rock

- QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** completed 17 of 25 atts. for 297 yds., 3 TDs and a passer rating of 131.2. His 3 TD passes tied a career high and were the most as a member of the 49ers [3 TDs vs. Mia. (9/18/16)].
- Garoppolo's 131.2 passer rating was his highest as a member of the 49ers (min. 25 atts.) and highest since 9/18/16 vs. Mia. (135.4).

Breida The Cheetah

- RB **Matt Breida** registered 12 carries for 121 yds. (10.08 avg.). It marked his 4th career game with 100-or-more rushing yds. and first since 11/25/18 at TB (106 yds.).
- Breida's 10.08 rushing avg. was the 2nd-highest of his career (min. 10 atts.) and the highest by a member of the 49ers since Breida averaged 12.55 yds. per carry vs. Det. (9/16/18).

Mostert Parts The Orange Sea

- RB **Raheem Mostert** registered his first career TD recept. on a 39-yd. pass from Garoppolo. His 39-yd. recept. is also the longest of his career.
- Mostert also added 13 carries for 83 yds. on the ground.

Wilson!

- RB **Jeff Wilson Jr.** registered 10 carries for 34 yds. and 2 TDs. His 2-yd. and 4-yd. TD runs were the first and 2nd of his career.
- Wilson Jr. became the first member of the 49ers to register 2-or-more rushing TDs in a single game since RB Carlos Hyde at LAR (12/31/17 – 2 TDs).

George Of The Jungle

- TE **George Kittle** registered 3 receipts. for 54 yds. With 54 rec. yds. on the day, he now has 2,000 career rec. yds. in 33 career regular season games. He now ranks t-3rd in NFL history as the fastest TE to reach 2,000-or-more career rec. yds.

You're In Good Hands With Goodwin

- QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** connected with WR **Marquise Goodwin** on a 38-yd. TD recept. It marked Goodwin's first TD recept. of the season and 13th of his career. He finished the game with 3 receipts. for 77 yds. and 1 TD.

Deebo Steals A TD

- WR **Deebo Samuel** registered 5 receipts. for 87 yds. and 1 TD. His first career TD receipt. came on a 3-yd. pass from Jimmy Garoppolo.

You Can't Run Here

- **San Francisco** held the Bengals to 25 rushing yds. on 19 carries (1.3 avg.), the fewest rushing yds. allowed and lowest yds. per carry allowed by the team since 11/8/15 vs. Atl. [14 carries for 17 rushing yds. (1.2 avg.)].

Gimme That

- The **49ers defense** intercepted Bengals QB Andy Dalton once on the day. Through the first 2 Weeks of the season, the team has 4 INTs, the most by the 49ers in Weeks 1-2 since the 1995 season (4 INTs).

Tae-Kwon-Do

- LB **Kwon Alexander** intercepted Dalton, marking his first INT as a member of the 49ers, 7th of his career, and his first since 2017 as a member of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers.
- Alexander's INT led to a K **Robbie Gould** 33-yd. FG.

Stretch Armstead

- On the first play of the game DL **Arik Armstead** brought down Cincinnati Bengals QB Andy Dalton for an 8-yd. loss.
- Armstead now has 2.0 sacks on the season and has registered at least 1.0 sack in back-to-back games for the 2nd time in his career.

Buck Wild

- DL **DeForest Buckner** brought down Dalton for a 6-yd. loss, his first sack of the season. He now has 22.0 sacks for his career.

If You Like Winning...

- DL **Ronald Blair III** sacked Dalton for a 5-yd. loss and now has 11.5 sacks for his career.
