GET OUT AND VOTE

- For the second-consecutive week and the 3rd time in 4 Weeks, DL **Nick Bosa** is one of five players nominated for the Pepsi NFL Rookie of the Week Award. Fans can vote for Bosa at <http://www.nfl.com/voting/rookies/2019/REG/8> through Friday at 12:00 p.m. PT. He also won NFC Defensive Player of the Week for the 2nd time this season (Week 5).



- Last week vs. Car. (10/27/19), Bosa registered 4 tackles, 3 TFLs, a career-high 3.0 sacks and his 1st career INT. His 3.0 sacks on the day were the most in the NFL in Week 8.
- Bosa joined Vikings DE/DT Kevin Williams [at Arz. (12/28/03)] and Panthers DE Julius Peppers [at Dal. (10/13/02)] as the only rookies to have at least 3.0 sacks and an interception in a single game since 1982. He also became the first NFL player since Chiefs DL Chris Jones in 2017 [vs. Phi. (9/17/17)] with 3.0-or-more sacks and 1-or-more INT in a single game.



- After rushing for 105 yds. and tying a career high with 3 rushing TDs on 11 carries (9.5 avg.) on the ground last week vs. Car. (10/27/19), RB **Tevin Coleman** is one of three RBs nominated for FedEx Ground NFL Player of the Week. Voting for this week's winners is open until Thursday at 12:00 p.m. PT at <http://www.nfl.com/voting/players-air-and-ground/2019/REG/8>. Fans can also vote on Twitter and Facebook using the NFL published polls.
- Coleman also added 2 receipts. for 13 yds. and 1 TD on the day. He became the first player in franchise history to register 3 rushing TDs and 1 rec. TD in the same game.
- Coleman's 3 rushing TDs in Week 8 were the most in the NFL, with no other player having more than 1 rushing TD, while his 4 total TDs in Week 8 were also the most in the NFL. His 4 total TDs on the day were also the most by a member of the 49ers since WR Jerry Rice had 4 rec. TDs at TB (11/14/93).

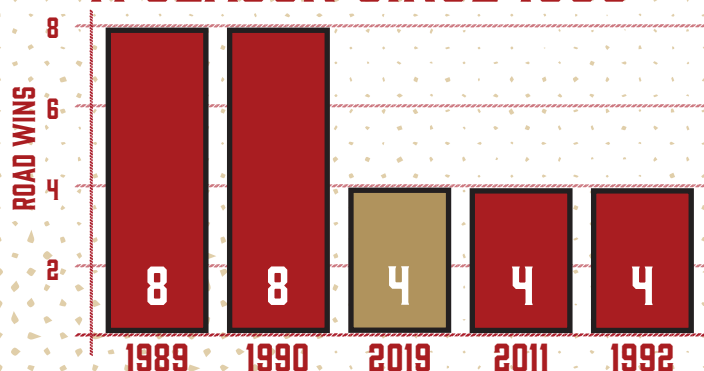


ROAD WARRIORS

This week at Arz. (10/31/19), the 49ers look for their 5th-consecutive road win to start the season.

- San Francisco's 4 road wins to start the 2019 season are the most to begin a season by the team since 2011 and tied for the 3rd-most by the 49ers since 1989.

With the win at Arz....

- The 49ers would earn 5-consecutive road victories in a season for the first time since the 1997 season.
- The Niners would begin a season with 5-or-more road wins for the 5th time in franchise history and the first time since 1990 (8 straight road wins).

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- The Niners have scored 119 2nd-half points this season, ranking 3rd in the NFL (LAR - 125; Hou. - 124). San Francisco has scored a NFL-high 72 points in the 3rd Qtr. this season.
- The 49ers punt coverage units have allowed just 2 punt return yds. this season, the fewest in the NFL.
