LE'VEON BELL: In his second game with the Jets, running back **Le'Veon Bell** produced 129 yards from scrimmage, including 68 rushing yards and 61 receiving yards on 10 receptions. For **Bell**, the 10 catches mark his fourth game with at least 10 receptions.

Bell currently leads all NFL running backs in catches (16) through the first two weeks.

LUKE FALK: After being claimed off waivers this offseason, second-year quarterback **Luke Falk** was elevated from the practice squad prior to the game vs. CLV (9/16) before replacing an injured Trevor Siemian in the second quarter.

Falk completed 80% of his passes (20-of-25) in his NFL debut, only the third time an NFL quarterback has completed 80%+ (with at least 20 attempts) in their first game since the AFL/ NFL merger in 1970.

NEVILLE HEWITT: Hewitt, now in his second season as a Jet, started the first two games of the season, posting a teamleading 14 tackles as well as an interception and a sack. Hewitt joins BUF safety Jordan Poyer and TEN cornerback Logan Ryan as the only three players in 2019 with 10+ tackles, a sack and an interception.

OFFENSE

KEY RESERVES

WR 11 ROBBY ANDERSON 4th Season

Last season, led the team in receptions (50), receiving yards (752) and receiving touchdowns (6), while producing a single-season best 15.0 yards per catch. Has caught 15 touchdown passes since entering the league (2016), the fourth most of any undrafted free agent in that span.

LT 68 KELVIN BEACHUM 8th Season

Team captain who has started all 34 games at left tackle since joining the Jets (2017). Helped protect Sam Darnold, who became the youngest player to start at quarterback and the youngest to throw for 300 yards.

LG 70 KELECHI OSEMELE 8th Season

Two-time Pro Bowl guard who was acquired via trade this offseason. Last season, he blocked for a rushing offense that gained 1,600 yards and saw three different backs each produce 4.1 yards per carry.

C 55 RYAN KALIL 13th Season

Five-time Pro Bowl selection joined the Jets during training camp after coming out of retirement. Has started 147 games in his career, including all 16 last season.

RG 67 BRIAN WINTERS 7th Season

Longest-tenured Jets offensive lineman after joining the team in 2013. Started all 16 games last season, helping block for a rushing offense that gained over 150 yards on the ground three times, including a 323-yard rushing performance vs. DEN (10/07/18).

RT 72 BRANDON SHELL 4th Season

Set career highs in games played and games started after starting 14 games last season. Helped protect Sam Darnold, who became the youngest player to start at quarterback and the youngest to throw for 300 yards.

TE 84 RYAN GRIFFIN 7th Season

Signed to the team as a free agent prior to the start of training camp and started in his Jets debut vs. BUF (9/8). For his career, has caught 139 passes for 1,501 yards and seven touchdowns.

WR 82 JAMISON CROWDER 5th Season

In his Jets debut vs. BUF (9/8), matched Al Toon's single-game record for most receptions by a wide receiver as he pulled in 14 passes for 99 yards. This season, he is tied for first in the AFC with 18 receptions.

WR 18 **DEMARYIUS THOMAS** 10th Season

Acquired via trade prior to Week Two, the four-time Pro Bowler ranks fifth in receiving yards (9,330) and third in receiving touchdowns (62) among active wide receivers in the league.

QB 8 LUKE FALK 2nd Season

Came in relief of an injured Trevor Siemian last week vs. CLV and completed 80% of his passes (20-of-25) for 198 yards and a 99.7 passer rating.

RB 26 LE'VEON BELL 6th Season

Became the fastest player (63 career games) to reach 8,000 yards from scrimmage when he surpassed the total in his first play as a Jet. Has averaged 128.4 yards per game played in his career, the best in NFL history among all players with at least 50 games played.

WR 15 JOSH BELLAMY 5th Season

Unrestricted free agent signing who has appeared in 77 career games, including 64-of-65 since 2015. Key contributor on special teams with 23 career special teams tackles.

WR/RB 88 TY MONTGOMERY 5th Season

Unrestricted free agent signing who has seen action at both running back and wide receiver in his career. Has averaged 4.88 yards per carry since entering the league (2015).

RB 29 BILAL POWELL 9th Season

The team's longest-tenured player. Last season, he moved into 10th place on the franchise's all-time rushing list with 3,446 yards, two yards from passing Adrian Murrell for ninth place.

C 78 JONOTTHAN HARRISON 6th Season

In his third season with the Jets, he has appeared in 26 of a possible 34 games since 2017. Has started 32 games in 70 career appearances.

SPECIALISTS

P 4 LACHLAN EDWARDS 4th Season

Set single-season franchise records in net punting average in each of the last two seasons (40.5 and 40.8), opening the 2019 season vs. BUF (9/8) by matching his single-game best with five punts inside the 20-yard line, including one downed at the two-yard line which led to a safety on the ensuing play.

K 9 **SAM FICKEN** 1st Season

Connected on a 46-yard field goal, the longest made field goal of his career in his Jets debut vs. CLV (9/16) after signing earlier in the week.

LS 42 THOMAS HENNESSY 3rd Season

Appeared in all 34 games since joining the team via trade (2017). Helped Jason Myers convert 91% of his field goal attempts en route to Myers' Pro Bowl season (2018) and helped Lachlan Edwards establish a franchise record in net punting average for the second straight season. Leads the team in special teams tackles this season with three.

DEFENSE

DL 92 **LEONARD WILLIAMS** 5th Season

Has appeared in every game for the Jets (starting 65 of 66) since being drafted (2015). Since 2015, his 88 quarterback hits (according to Radar360) are the fifth most among all AFC defensive players. Led the team in quarterback hits in each of his four seasons.

DL 99 STEVE McLENDON 10th Season

Veteran leader and two-time team captain, he has appeared in 124 career games, including all 34 since 2017. Recovered a fumble to end the opening drive vs. BUF (9/8).

DL 96 HENRY ANDERSON 5th Season

Produced a career-high 7.0 sacks in his first season with the Jets to co-lead the team. Re-signed this offseason.

OLB 48 JORDAN JENKINS 4th Season

Registered the first Jets sack of the season when he dropped Josh Allen for a 12-yard loss, forcing a fumble that the Jets recovered in the season opening game vs. BUF (9/8). The strip-sack was the fifth of his career.

ILB 57 C.J. MOSLEY 6th Season

Four-time Pro Bowl selection and team captain who registered an interception (17-yard pick six) and fumble recovery in his Jets debut vs. BUF (9/8), becoming one of just eight Jets linebackers since 1991 to do so and the only one with a touchdown. Missed the previous game vs. CLV with an injury.

ILB 46 NEVILLE HEWITT 5th Season

Team leader in tackles (14) has started both games this season and registered an interception vs. BUF (9/8) and sack vs. CLV (9/16).

OLB 44 HARVEY LANGI 2nd Season

Started in his Jets debut vs. BUF (9/8) and deflected a pass leading to a Neville Hewitt interception.

CB 22 TRUMAINE JOHNSON 8th Season

In 2018, allowed just a 73.3 passer rating when targeted following his return from injury in Week 10, the fifth lowest among all cornerbacks with at least 400 defensive snaps in that span (according to Radar360). Finished the season with a team-leading four interceptions, the most by a Jet since 2015.

CB 27 DARRYL ROBERTS 5th Season

Second on the team in tackles (13). Recorded the third interception of his career, a pick last week vs. CLV (9/16). Finished in the top five among Jets defensive backs in passes defensed each of the last three seasons.

S 33 JAMAL ADAMS 3rd Season

2018 Curtis Martin Team MVP who earned his first Pro Bowl selection and was a second-team All Pro last season after finishing in the top three among all NFL safeties in almost every defensive category including tackles (115), tackles for loss (nine), sacks (3.5), quarterback hits (eight), passes defensed (12), forced fumbles (three) and fumble recoveries (one).

S 20 MARCUS MAYE 3rd Season

Has started all 24 games he appeared in, recording 116 tackles, three interceptions, seven passes defensed and two forced fumbles. Among active Jets defensive players, ranks second in interceptions since 2017.

KEY RESERVES

LB 50 FRANKIE LUVU 2nd Season

Last season, as an undrafted rookie free agent, registered 32 tackles, 3.0 sacks and 19 quarterback hits, the most sacks by a Jets undrafted rookie since 1996.

S 45 RONTEZ MILES 5th Season

Team captain who entered the 2019 season as the team's longest tenured defensive player. For his career, has recorded 89 tackles, an interception and two forced fumbles on defense, while delivering 53 tackles as a special teams standout and the team leader in that category since 2016.

CB 21 NATE HAIRSTON 3rd Season

Acquired via trade before the start of the regular season, has seen action in both games season including starting last week vs. CLV (9/16) and registering three tackles (including one for loss) and a pass defensed.

CB 34 BRIAN POOLE 4th Season

Teamed with Jordan Jenkins to drop Frank Gore for a two-yard loss and a safety on the opening BUF possession of the second half, the team's first safety on a rushing play since 2011.

Entered the league as the third-overall pick by the Jets in the 2019 NFL Draft. At the University of Alabama, totaled 91 tackles, including 26 tackles for loss and 10.0 sacks as part of a team that made the National Championship game each of his three seasons on campus. BY THE NUMBERS

This season, linebacker **Neville Hewitt** joins BUF safety Jordan Poyer and TEN cornerback Logan Ryan as the only three players in 2019 with 10+ tackles, a sack and an interception.

Since entering the league in 2016, linebacker **Jordan Jenkins** is one of just three players with at least five forced fumbles, five fumble recoveries and 10.0 sacks.

Cornerback **Brian Poole** joins a pair of Pro Bowl safeties, Kevin Byard and Harrison Smith, as the only three defensive backs with 20+ passes defensed, 10+ tackles for loss and 10+ quarterback hits since 2016.

The Jets defense registered four takeaways in the first half vs. BUF (9/8), their first game with four-plus in the opening half since they did so at PHI (12/18/11). It also marked only the third time a Jets defense has forced four+ takeaways in the first half of a season opener since 1995 [at MIA] and 1965 (at HOU).

Linebacker **Frankie Luvu**, an undrafted free agent in 2018, was one of just six rookies last season with 3.0+ sacks, 5+ tackles for loss and 10+ quarterback hits and the only one not selected in the draft's first five rounds.

Defensive lineman **Henry Anderson** finished 2018 with a career high 7.0 sacks, one of just nine 3-4 defensive linemen with at least 7.0 sacks last season...0f those nine, five players were selected for the Pro Bowl.

In his Jets debut vs. BUF (9/8), wide receiver **Jamison Crowder** caught 14 passes, tied for the most by a Jets receiver in a single game in franchise history.

Wide receiver **Robby Anderson** produced a career best 15.0 yards per catch last season (2018), the best by a Jets qualified receiver (min. 32 rec.) since Braylon Edwards in 2010.

In his Jets debut vs. BUF (9/8), Pro Bowl linebacker **C.J. Mosley** picked off a pass returning it 17 yards for a touchdown. For Mosley, the score was the third of his career and second pick-six.

Cornerback **Darryl Roberts** has registered 25 passes defensed after joining the Jets (2016), the most of any active player on the roster during that period.

After pacing the team in tackles with 37 over the final four weeks of the 2018 season, linebacker **Neville Hewitt**, leads the team through two weeks this season with 14.

Since the 2016 season, safety **Rontez Miles** has produced 40 special teams tackles (according to coach's stats), the most of any Jets player over that time period.

GENERAL MANAGER

JOE DOUGLAS was named general manager of the New York Jets by Christopher Johnson on June 7, 2019. In introducing him, Johnson stated that Douglas is, "The right person, at the right time," for the franchise, someone who shared Johnson's vision not just for the team, but the entire organization.

In his 20th season in the league, Douglas has put in the work and paid his dues, working as both a pro and college scout in Baltimore, Chicago and Philadelphia, and helping shape three different Super Bowl championship rosters.

"My first steps and priorities here are simply to engage and connect with the entire organization," Douglas said during his press conference. "Adam Gase and I share a vision of building a team and I look forward to partnering with him and getting this program to a place where we are consistently competing for championships each and every year.

"To Jets nation, you are getting a general manager that is a relentless worker, someone that understands a winning culture, someone that is going to strive to put a product on the field each Sunday that competes for greatness and that I hope will make you proud."

Before joining the Jets, Douglas spent the previous three seasons as the vice president of player personnel with the Eagles. In Philadelphia, he was a key component in acquiring many of the players that helped win Super Bowl LII, including the game's MVP, quarterback Nick Foles.

Using every avenue to help improve the team, Douglas was part of a front office that acquired the players who scored all but two of the team's postseason touchdowns, including four of the five touchdowns in the Super Bowl. A trio of 2017 unrestricted free agent signings - LeGarrette Blount, Foles and Alshon Jeffery - as well as a pair of street free agents - Patrick Robinson and Torrey Smith - all contributed scores on the team's title run. The Eagles' leading receiver in the Super Bowl, running back Corey Clement, was signed as an undrafted free agent, while the team's leading rusher in the game, running back Jay Ajayi, joined the club as a midseason trade.

Prior to joining the Eagles, Douglas spent a season as the director of college scouting for Chicago (2015), first working with Gase, the then offensive coordinator for the Bears.

Entering the NFL as a player personnel assistant (2000) the year Baltimore won Super Bowl XXXV, Douglas ascended within the Ravens organization, holding various posts in the organization's scouting department, serving as a national scout (2012-15), Southeast area scout (2009-11), East Coast area scout (2008) and Northeast area scout (2003-07), helping add a number of prominent players via the draft, including the Super Bowl XLVII MVP, quarterback Joe Flacco, as well as a number of Pro Bowl players – Ben Grubbs, C.J. Mosley, Justin Tucker and Marshal Yanda.

An All-Atlantic 10 selection, Douglas started 45 consecutive games at tackle for the University of Richmond. Following his collegiate playing career, he transitioned into a volunteer assistant coach role with the Spiders in 1999.

As an offensive and defensive lineman at Lee-Davis (VA) HS, Douglas was recognized as a two-time all-state honoree.

He and his wife, Shannon, have two daughters, Addison and Leighton, and a son, Thomas.

HYMIE ELHAI is in his 20th year with the Jets and first as team president. Beginning with the Jets in 2000 as an intern, Elhai most recently served as the club's senior vice president, business affairs and general counsel where he was responsible for all legal aspects of the team, including sponsorship, licensing, event, digital media, production and broadcasting agreements, and all employment related matters.

"I am honored to be given this opportunity and thankful to The Johnson Family for entrusting me with the responsibility and all that comes along with it," said Elhai. "I have a deep appreciation and respect for this franchise, what it means to our fans, the communities we serve, as well as our business partners."

In his current role, Elhai will report directly to Chairman & CEO Christopher Johnson and oversee all team business operations, while working closely with both General Manager Joe Douglas and Head Coach Adam Gase to integrate football and business operations.

"For over 20 years Hymie has developed a deep level of respect from both sides of the building," said Johnson.

"Over that time, he has grown to be an invaluable and trusted confidant for many, including, in recent years, myself. Specifically, I witnessed first-hand, his leadership, communication and organizational acumen during our recent head coach and general manager searches. I expect Hymie to be a key unifier, working alongside Adam and Joe, for our organization moving forward."

For the past couple of seasons, Elhai has also provided counsel and guidance to football administration on all planning initiatives.

A Sports Business Journal Forty Under 40 honoree in 2016, Elhai is a graduate of Rutgers Law School and The Johns Hopkins University, where he played football and baseball. Elhai resides in Hoboken, NJ.



ADAM GASE



HEAD GOACH

ADAM GASE was named the head coach of the New York Jets by Chairman & CEO Christopher Johnson on January 11, 2019. For Gase, he becomes the 17th full-time coach in franchise history.

Under Gase, starting quarterbacks have produced 38 games with a 100+ passer rating, a number that would tie him for 10th among all NFL franchises since 2013 – higher than the total of all three franchises he's worked with in that span. Additionally, every quarterback (Peyton Manning, Jay Cutler, Ryan Tannehill, Matt Moore and Brock Osweiler) who has started at least two games for him has produced a 100+ passer rating performance. Since 2013 (his first season calling plays), nine different running backs have produced 100-yard games under Gase, while in his three seasons as Miami's head coach, the Dolphins ground game averaged 4.36 yards per carry, the 10th best average in the league, and Miami running backs accounted for a 4.49 average, the third best in the league. Additionally, Dolphins running backs have 33 carries of 20+ yards in that span, tied for the fourth most in the league.

Beginning with his first season in Denver (2009), he has coached 16 different players to the Pro Bowl, including 12 offensive players — multiple players at offensive line, wide receiver and running back.

Prior to his appointment as Jets head coach, Gase spent 16 seasons as a coach in the NFL, the last six calling plays for three different franchises, including record-setting offensive output as the offensive coordinator of the Denver Broncos (2013), his first season calling plays in the NFL. In his last position, Gase spent three seasons (2016-18) as the head coach for the Miami Dolphins, where he compiled a 23-25 record and led the franchise to a postseason berth in his first season.

As the Dolphins head coach, he posted a 20-6 record in onescore games (+/- eight points), a .769 winning percentage, the best among any team in the league. Buoyed by the fact that his team registered the sixth most touchdowns in the fourth quarter of close games (+/- seven points), Gase also saw his quarterbacks post the 10th highest passer rating in those scenarios.

YPSILANTI, MI | 🦝 MICHIGAN STATE

In his first season under Gase's leadership (2016), Tannehill posted the most efficient season of his NFL career, completing 67.1% of his passes for a 7.7 yards per attempt average and a 93.5 passer rating, all career highs, while also leading the league with a red zone passer rating of 119.7 as the Dolphins broke an eight-year playoff drought.

Before his time in South Florida, Gase spent a season as the offensive coordinator with the Chicago Bears (2015), improving the team's rushing yardage ranking from No. 27 the season before to No. 11. Under his tutelage, Cutler finished the season with the highest passer rating (92.3) of his career, threw seven fewer interceptions than the previous season, and posted a single-season-best 2.3 percent interception rate.

Prior to Chicago, Gase served on the Broncos staff in a variety of roles, including offensive coordinator (2013-14), quarterbacks coach (2011-12) and wide receivers coach (2009-10) as Denver won four AFC West titles, three playoff games and an AFC Championship.

In two seasons as the offensive coordinator (2013-14), Gase oversaw a record-setting offense that produced over 430 yards per game, including 315.8 yards per game passing and 34 points per game, all the best in the league over that span. In 2013, they set NFL single-season records for most points scored (606) and most passing yards (5,444), while five different players (three wide receivers, a tight end and a running back) all scored 10+touchdowns.

Additionally, Manning established single-season NFL records in passing yards (5,477) and passing touchdowns (55), earning NFL Most Valuable Player honors for his efforts. In three seasons under Gase (2012-14), Manning posted a 131-to-35 touchdown to interception ratio, completing 67.7% of his passes for a passer rating of 107.8.

ADAM GASE



In his first season as the team's quarterbacks coach (2011), Gase oversaw quarterbacks Kyle Orton and Tim Tebow, as the latter helped guide the team to a division title and a postseason berth. Under Gase, Tebow ran for 660 yards and six touchdowns, at the time, the ninth-highest rushing total by a quarterback since the merger.

He initially served on Denver's staff as the team's wide receivers coach (2009-10). In those years, he coached a pair of Pro Bowlers, first wide receiver Brandon Marshall (2009), who produced 101 receptions for 1,120 yards and 10 touchdowns, and then wide receiver Brandon Lloyd (2010), who led the league with 1,448 yards on 77 receptions (18.8 average).

Before joining the Broncos staff, Gase spent one season with San Francisco as an offensive assistant under Offensive Coordinator Mike Martz, assisting an offense that saw running back Frank Gore produce over 1,000 yards rushing.

Gase entered the NFL ranks with the Detroit Lions in 2003, serving as scouting/coaching assistant for three seasons under Steve Mariucci before becoming an offensive quality control coach in 2006 and the quarterbacks coach in 2007 under Rod Marinelli. In his season as quarterbacks coach, Jon Kitna posted 4,068 passing yards, the second-highest total of his 14-year career, finishing sixth in the league in passing yards.
