## MONDAY NIGHT MADNESS

- This week vs. Sea. (11/11/19), the 49ers look for their 50th career win on *Monday Night Football*. San Francisco's 49 wins on MNF are the most in NFL history.
- The 49ers look for their 2nd win on *Monday Night Football* this season [W, 31-3 vs. Cle. (10/7/19)] which would be their most wins in a season on MNF since 2013 (2 wins).



• In RB **Tevin Coleman's** 5 career games on *Monday Night Football*, he has registered 79 carries for 312 yds. and 6 TDs. He has at least 1 rushing TD in 4 of his 5 appearances on MNF, including 1-or-more in 4 straight.

• Since entering the NFL in 2015, Coleman's 6 rushing TDs on *Monday Night Football* are the most in the NFL over that span.

- In his 3 career games on *Monday Night Football*, RB **Matt Breida** has registered 42 carries for 276 yds. (6.57 avg.) and 3 TDs on the ground to go along with 6 receipts. for 46 yds. and 2 TDs through the air. He has at least 1 rushing TD in all 3 of his appearances on MNF.
- Since entering the NFL in 2017, Breida's 5 total touchdowns (3 rushing & 2 receiving) on *Monday Night Football* are the most in the NFL over that span.
- In San Francisco's Week 5 game vs. Cle. on *Monday Night Football*, Breida registered a max speed of 22.30 MPH on a 83-yd. TD run, making him the fastest ball carrier in the NFL on the season, according to the NFL's Next Gen Stats.
- Also vs. Cle., DL **Nick Bosa** earned NFC Defensive Player of the Week honors after registering 4 tackles, 2.0 sacks, 1 FF and 1 FR.



## CROCODILE PUNTEE

- P **Mitch Wishnowsky** earned NFC Special Teams Player of the Week for his Week 9 performance at Arz. (10/31/19) after registering 5 punts (3 downed at the 10-or-less) for 231 yds. (42.8 net avg.). He joined DL Nick Bosa (Week 5) as 1 of 2 San Francisco rookies that have won Player of the Week honors.
- Of Wishnowsky's 25 punts on the season, 13 have been downed inside the 20. With 52.0% of his punts downed inside the 20, he ranks t-3rd in the NFL.

## GOLDEN NUGGETS

- After connecting on 28 of 37 atts. for 317 yds., a career-high 4 TDs and a career-high passer rating of 136.9 last week at Arz. (10/31/19), QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** is 1 of 3 QBs nominated for FedEx Air NFL Player of the Week. Voting for this week's winners is open until Thursday at 12:00 p.m. PT at <http://www.nfl.com/voting/players-air-and-ground/2019/REG/9>. Fans can also vote on Twitter and Facebook using the NFL published polls.
- With the win vs. Sea. (11/11/19), the 49ers would start 2019 with 4-consecutive wins at home, marking the first time since the 2011 season that San Francisco would register a home winning streak of 4-or-more games (2011 - 6 games). The last time the team began a season with 4-or-more home victories was 1998 (8-0 at home).
- The 49ers defense has registered 3.0-or-more sacks in 7 of the team's 8 games this season (the most in the NFL), including each of the past 5 contests. With 3.0-or-more sacks this week, the 2019 Niners would reach 3.0 sacks in 8 games in a season for the first time since 2011 and the 9th time since 1990.
- The 49ers have an average time of possession of 34:31 this season, ranking 2nd in the NFL (Bal. - 35:23).

- So far this season, 47 San Francisco 49ers players have spent 233 hours in the Bay Area community, participating in 12 community events which have impacted the lives of 809 kids and 891 adults over the past 10 weeks.
