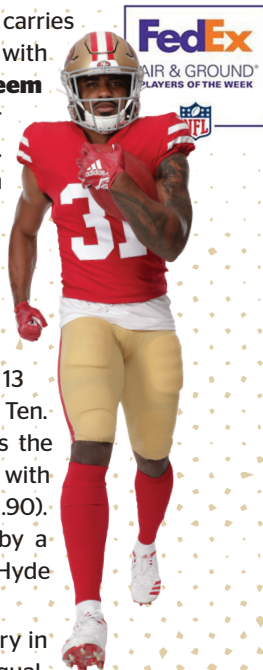

RAHEEM THE DREAM

- After registering career highs in both carries (19) and rushing yds. (146) to go along with 1 TD last week at Bal. (12/1/19), RB **Raheem Mostert** is 1 of 3 RBs nominated for FedEx Ground NFL Player of the Week. Voting for this week's winners is open until Thursday at 12:00 p.m. PT at <http://www.nfl.com/voting/players-air-and-ground/2019/REG/13>. Fans can also vote on Twitter and Facebook using the NFL published polls.
- Mostert's** 146 rushing yds. in Week 13 ranked 2nd in the NFL (Derrick Henry, Ten. - 149), while his 7.68 rushing avg. was the 2nd-highest in the NFL among players with 10-plus carries (Derrius Guice, Was. - 12.90). His 146 rushing yds. were the most by a member of the 49ers since RB Carlos Hyde had 193 rushing yds. vs. NYJ (12/11/16).
- Mostert** is averaging 5.86 yds. per carry in 2019, ranking 2nd in the NFL among all qualifying players (Lamar Jackson, Bal. - 6.98) and 1st among RBs.
- Mostert** also leads the 49ers with 10 tackles and 1 FR on special teams in 2019.



GOLDEN NUGGETS

- The 49ers have totaled 49 big plays (runs for 10-or-more yds. & receipts. of 20-or-more yds.) on 1st down this season, the most in the NFL.
- CB **Richard Sherman** has registered 1 INT in each of the 49ers 2 games against NFC South opponents this season [1 INT at TB (9/8/19) & 1 INT vs. Car. (10/27/19)].
- RB **Tevin Coleman** has registered 1 TD receipt. in each of his last 3 games against the Saints. He also picked up 3 rushing TDs at NO on 9/26/16 as a member of the Atlanta Falcons.
- San Francisco's 7 regular season wins in the months of December/January since 2017 are tied for the 4th-most in the NFL and tied for the most in the NFC (LAR - 7; Phi. - 7; Sea. - 7).
- The Niners aim for their 3rd win against the NFC South this season, with the team's final game versus the division coming in Week 15 vs. Atl. (12/15/19).

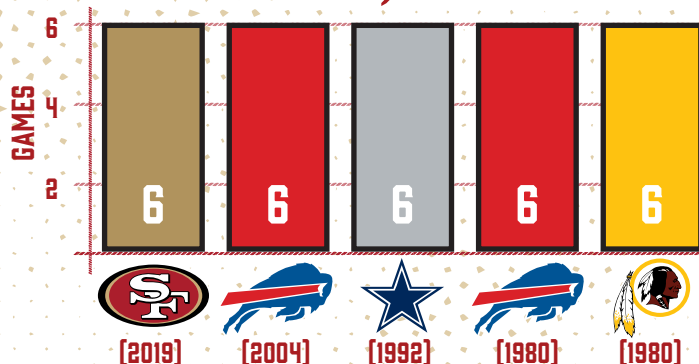
SOMEONE LET THE AIR OUT

- The 49ers defense has held opposing offenses to an average of 134.3 total net passing yds. per game this season, ranking 1st in the NFL.
- The Niners have allowed 85 passing 1st downs this season, the fewest in the NFL.
- San Francisco has held opponents under 110 net passing yds. 6 times this season, including 5 games with 100-or-less net passing yds. allowed. The team's 6 games with fewer than 110 net passing yds. allowed are the most in a single season in the NFL since the 2004 Buffalo Bills (6 games) and tied for the most in the NFL since 1980.
