PRESEASON WEEK 2 at NEW ENGLAND

The Chicago Bears (0-1) will travel to New England for their first preseason road contest of 2016 when they take on the Patriots (1-0) at Gillette Stadium on Thursday, August 18 at 7:00 pm CT.

The Bears begin their second season under head coach John Fox and general manager Ryan Pace. The Bears finished the season with a 6-10 record last season.

Fox is 125-99 (.558) in the regular season as a head coach with the Carolina Panthers (2002-10), Denver Broncos (2011-14) and Chicago Bears (2015), leading his teams to six division titles, six double-digit win seasons and seven playoff appearances. In the postseason, Fox has amassed an 8-7 (.533) record as a head coach with three conference championship game appearances leading to two trips to the Super Bowl (XXXVIII with Carolina in 2003 and XLVIII with Denver in 2013). He is one of six coaches in NFL history to lead two different teams to Super Bowl appearances along with Don Shula, Bill Parcells, Dan Reeves, Dick Vermeil and Mike Holmgren.

Notable additions the Bears roster this offseason include linebackers Jerrell Freeman and Danny Trevathan, defensive lineman Akiem Hicks, offensive linemen Bobby Massie and Ted Larsen and quarterback Brian Hoyer.

The Bears acquired nine players in the 2016 NFL Draft, six on the defensive side of the ball. They started the draft by moving up two spots in the first round, selecting linebacker Leonard Floyd (ninth overall). In the third round they selected defensive lineman Jonathan Bullard (72nd overall), in the fourth, linebacker Nick Kwiatkoski (113th overall) and defensive backs Deon Bush (124th overall) and Deiondre' Hall (124th overall), and picked up defensive back DeAndre Houston-Carson in the sixth round (185th overall). Offensively, the Bears selected offensive lineman Cody Whitehair (second round, 56th overall), running back Jordan Howard (fifth round, 150th overall) and wide receiver Daniel Braverman (seventh round, 230th overall).

Fox has compiled a 31-25 (.553) record in the preseason as a head coach.

THE HEAD COACHES

CHICAGO BEARS

John Fox

John Fox was named the 15th head coach in Chicago Bears history on January 16, 2015. Before joining the Bears, John Fox was a head coach with the Denver Broncos (2011-14) and Carolina Panthers (2002-2010). He has compiled a 125-99 (.558) regular season record, six division titles, six double-digit win seasons and seven playoff appearances. In the postseason, Fox has amassed an 8-7 (.533) record as a head coach with three conference championship game appearances leading to two trips to the Super Bowl (XXXVIII with Carolina in 2003 and XLVIII with Denver in 2013). Prior to coaching the Panthers, Fox was the defensive coordinator for the N.Y. Giants (1997-2001). In 2000, Fox helped the Giants reach Super Bowl XXXV, including posting the first shutout in a conference title game since 1986. Before joining the Giants, he was a Rams' consultant (1996), defensive coordinator for the Raiders (1994-95), defensive backs coach for the Chargers (1992-93) and Steelers (1989-1991), and secondary coach for the USFL's L.A. Express (1985). Fox also coached collegiately at San Diego St. (1978), U.S. International (1979) Boise St. (1980), Long Beach St. (1981), Utah (1982), Kansas (1983), Iowa St. (1984), and Pittsburgh (1986-88).

NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS

Bill Belichick

Bill Belichick is in his 42st season as an NFL coach and his 17th season as head coach of the New England Patriots, hired on Jan. 27, 2000. Belichick has led the Patriots to 15 consecutive winning seasons (2001-15). Through 16 seasons with New England, Belichick has delivered four Super Bowl championships, six conference titles, 13 division crowns and 22 playoff victories. He owns an overall regular season record of 223-113 (.664). His .667 winning percentage ranks second all-time, behind George Halas (.682). Belichick directed the Patriots to victories in Super Bowls XXXVI (2001), XXXVIII (2003), XXXIX (2004) and XLIX (2014), and in 2007 he became the first NFL head coach to guide his team to a 16-0 regular season. Four Super Bowl Championships are tied with Pittsburgh's Chuck Noll for the most Super Bowl wins by a head coach. Belichick began his coaching career in 1975 with the Baltimore Colts and continued as an assistant coach with the Detroit Lions (1976-77), Denver Broncos (1978) and the New York Giants (1979-1990). Belichick was named head coach of the Cleveland Browns in 1991. In 1996, he joined New England and helped the Patriots reach Super Bowl XXXI. Belichick then spent three seasons with the New York Jets (1997-99).

QUARTERBACKS (4)

Jay Cutler (NFL Career): Enters 11th NFL season having started all 134 games played with Denver (2006-08) and Chicago (2009-15), completing 2,701-of-4,354 pass attempts (62.0 percent) for 31,408 yards, 204 touchdowns and 141 interceptions for a QB rating of 86.0.

- Has added 1,626 rushing yards and 9 touchdowns on 362 career carries (4.5 ypc).
- Pro Bowl selection after 2008 season.
- 7-time team captain with Denver (2008) and Chicago (2009-13 & '15) [Bears had weekly captains during 2014 season].
- 39th in NFL history in passing yards.
- 37th in NFL history in passing touchdowns.

(Bears Career): Completed seventh season in Chicago as franchise leader in career passer rating (85.5), completions (1,939), attempts (3,134), completion percentage (61.9), passing yards (22,384), passing yards per game (230.8), passing touchdowns (150) and 300-yard passing games (16) in 97 starts.

- Has 1,203 rushing yards and 6 touchdowns on 249 attempts (4.8 ypc) with the Bears.
- Signed seven-year contract with the Bears in January of 2014.
- Broke the franchise mark for career passing touchdowns breaking a tie with Pro Football HOFer Sid Luckman (137) in Game 8 of the 2015 season at San Diego.

(2015 Season): Started 15 contests (Games 1-2 & 4-16), recording a career-high 92.3 passer rating after completing 311-of-483 attempts (64.4 percent) for 3,659 yards, 21 TDs and 11 INTs.

- Added 201 rushing yards and 1 TD on 38 carries (5.3 ypr).
- 11 interceptions were the fewest in a season in which he appeared in at least 15 games.

David Fales (NFL Career): Enters 3rd season with the Bears after being selected by Chicago in the sixth round (183rd overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft.

- Spent majority of the 2014 season on the Bears practice squad.
- Active but DNP in 8 contests during NFL career and Inactive in 6 others.

(2015 Season): Inactive in Games 1 and 4-5.

- Spent Week 2 on the practice squad before being elevated back to active roster during Week 3.
- Active but did not play in Games 3 and 11-16.
- Went back to practice squad from Oct. 14-Nov. 22 before being elevated back to active roster on November 23.

Brian Hoyer (NFL Career): Starts 8th professional season completing 580-of-999 passes (58.1 percent) for 7,163 yards in 43 games with 26 starts in 7 seasons with the New England Patriots (2009-11), Pittsburgh Steelers (2012), Arizona Cardinals (2012), Cleveland Browns (2013-14) and Houston Texans (2015).

- Owns 38 passing touchdowns and 26 interceptions
- Adds 119 rushing yards on 70 attempts with 1 rushing touchdown.

(2015 Season): Threw for a career-high 19 touchdowns while appearing in 11 games with 9 starts in his first year with the Texans.

- Completed 224-of-369 pass attempts for 2,606 yards and 7 interceptions for a 91.4 passer rating.
- Added 15 rush attempts for a career-high 44 yards (2.9 avg).

Connor Shaw (NFL Career): Begins second professional season, completing 14-of-28 pass attempts for 177 yards and 1 INT in 1 game (1 start) with the Cleveland Browns (2014).

- Adds 7 rush attempts for 9 yards.

(2015 Season): Missed the entire season with a thumb injury sustained during the preseason.

Ka'Deem Carey (NFL Career): Begins 3rd NFL season appearing in 25 games (1 start), taking 79 carries for 317 yards (4.0 ypc) and 2 TDs.

- Added 8 receptions for 76 yards (9.5 ypr) and 1 TD and 2 kickoff returns for 38 yards.

- Selected by Chicago in the fourth round (117th overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft

(2015 Season): Made 11 appearances (Games 3, 5-6, 8-10 & 12-16) with 1 start (Game 8), taking 43 carries for 159 yards (3.7 ypc) and 2 touchdowns and 3 catches for 19 yards and 1 touchdown.

- Adding 2 kickoffs for 38 yards.

- Scored first career touchdown (4-yard run) in Game 12 versus SF and made first career start in Game 8 at SD.

- Had first career 2 TD contest in Game 15 at Tampa Bay (1 rushing TD and 1st career receiving TD).

- Inactive in Games 1-2, 4 and 7 (coaches decision) and Game 11 due to a neck injury.

Jordan Howard (NFL Career): Starts 1st professional season after being selected by the Chicago Bears in the 5th round (150th overall) of the 2016 NFL Draft.

(College): Appeared in 32 career games over three seasons with UAB (2013-14) and Indiana (2015), compiling 3,681 rushing yards on 647 attempts (5.7 avg) and 24 rushing touchdowns, with 24 receptions for 261 yards (10.9) and 3 receiving touchdowns.

- Earned first team all-Big Ten (2015), first team all-CUSA (2014), and CUSA all-Freshman team (2013) honors

- Set UAB's single-season rushing yards record in the football program's final season (2014) with 1,587 yards

Jeremy Langford (NFL Career): Starts 2nd professional season after being selected by Chicago in the 4th round (106th overall) of the 2015 NFL Draft.

(2015 Season): Appeared in all 16 contests, with 2 starts (Game 9-10), carrying the ball 148 times for 537 yards (3.6 ypc) and 6 TDs and grabbing 22 receptions for 279 yards (12.7 ypr) and 1 TD.

- Added a 2-point conversion run and 1 special teams tackle.

Paul Lasike (NFL Career): Starts 2nd professional season without appearing in a regular season game.

(2015 Season): Spent a majority of the 2015 season on the Bears practice squad.

Senorise Perry (NFL Career): Enters 3rd season with the Bears after signing in 2014 as an undrafted rookie free agent out of Louisville.

- Appeared on special teams in 16 games with 4 kickoff returns for 88 yards, 17 special teams tackles and 2 forced fumbles on special teams.

- Has added 1 reception for -1 yards on offense.

(2015 Season): Spent entire 2015 regular season on Injured Reserve due to a foot injury.

Jacquizz Rodgers (NFL Career): Starts 6th NFL season and his first with the Bears, logging 1,157 yards on 319 carries (3.6 avg) and 1,114 yards on 156 catches (7.1 avg) and 10 total touchdowns (5 rushing and 5 receiving) in 68 career games including 5 starts with the Atlanta Falcons (2011-14) and Chicago Bears (2015).

- 2,271 yards from scrimmage.

- Also returned 50 kickoffs for 1,119 yards (23.8 avg)

- Logged 11 special teams tackles and recovered one opponent muffed punt.

(Bears Career): Wrapped up his first season with the Bears after signing a 1-year contract March 31, 2015.

(2015 Season): Carried the ball 14 times for 41 yards (2.9 ypc) and 1 reception for 10 yards, appearing as a reserve in 5 contests (Games 1-5).

- Added 1 kickoff return for 15 yards and 4 special teams tackles

- Had 1 takeaway, recovering an opponent's muffed punt.

Darrel Young (NFL Career): Begins 7th professional season having started 36-of-90 career games, totaling 185 rushing yards on 51 attempts (3.6 avg) and seven touchdowns.

- Owns 45 receptions for 432 yards (9.6 avg) and 6 touchdowns.

(2015 Season): Started 3-of-16 games, compiling 6 rush attempts for 10 yards and 6 receptions for 22 yards.

Joshua Bellamy (NFL Career): Begins 5th NFL season, appearing in 28 games (3 starts) with Kansas City (2012), Washington (2013) and Chicago (2014-15), hauling in 19 receptions for 224 yards and 2 touchdowns.

- Has 5 kickoff returns for 113 yards (22.6 ypr), 13 special teams tackles and 1 opponent fumble recovery on a muffed punt.

(Bears Career): Finished second season with the Bears, appearing in 20 contests (3 starts), hauling in 19 receptions for 224 yards and 2 TDs.

(2015 Season): Saw action in all 16 contests starting 3 (Games 12 & 15-16) at WR, hauling in 19 receptions for 224 yards and 2 TDs.

- Added 10 special teams tackles [second on the team] and an opponent fumble recovery on a muffed punt.

- First NFL catch was a 48-yard TD in Game 2.

- First Bears player since LB Brian Urlacher on 12/23/2001 at Washington to have his first career reception go for a TD.

- First Bears player since WR Marty Booker on 11/14/1999 vs. Minnesota to have his first career reception go for a TD of at least 48 yards (Booker's TD reception was 57 yards).

Daniel Braverman (NFL Career): Begins rookie season after being selected by the Bears in the 7th round (230th overall) of the 2016 NFL Draft.

(College): Started 27-of-37 games over three seasons at Western Michigan (2012, '14-15), hauling in 213 passes for 2,509 yards (11.8 avg) and 19 touchdowns.

- Added 76 yards on 12 rush attempts (6.3 avg).

- On special teams, posted 24 punt returns for 109 yards (4.5 avg) and 15 kickoff returns for 312 yards (20.8 avg).

BJ Daniel (NFL Career): Begins 2nd NFL season, appearing in 8 contests with the San Francisco 49ers (2013), Seattle Seahawks (2013-15) and Houston Texans (2015). He has also spent time with the New York Giants (2016).

- On offense, owns 2 receptions for 18 yards (9.0 avg), 6 rush attempts for 6 yards and has completed 1-of-2 pass attempts for 7 yards.

- On special teams, owns 5 punt returns for 25 yards (5.0 avg).

(2015 Season): Posted 6 rush attempts for 6 yards and 2 receptions for 18 yards in 8 games for the Seattle Seahawks and Houston Texans.

- Threw for 7 yards on 2 pass attempts with 1 completion.

- On special teams, tallied 5 punt returns for 25 yards (5.0 avg).

Kieren Duncan (NFL Career): Begins rookie season after signing with the Bears as an undrafted free agent.

(College): Appeared in 46 career games, producing 112 receptions for 1,914 yards and 14 touchdowns with 25 rush attempts for 284 yards and 2 touchdowns on offense.

- On special teams recorded 36 punt returns for 375 yards (10.4 avg) and 39 kickoff returns for 1,080 yards (27.7 ag) and 1 touchdown.

Alshon Jeffery (NFL Career): Starts 5th NFL season, hauling in 252 receptions for 3,728 yards (14.8 ypc) and 24 TDs.

- Has 12 career 100-yard receiving games in 51 games played with 44 starts at wide receiver.

- Has added 138 rushing yards on 22 carries (6.3 ypc).

- Earned first Pro Bowl nod and named PFWA's Most Improved Player after 2013 season.

- Finished with 1,421 receiving yards in 2013 (2nd most in single-season franchise history) and 1,133 receiving yards in 2014 (8th most).

- Had compiled 2 consecutive 1,000-yard receiving season ('13-14) becoming 4th Bears player to accomplish that feat: (M. Booker - '01 & '02, C. Conway - '95 & '96 and B. Marshall - '12 & '13) and 5th Bears player with multiple 1,000-yard receiving seasons (H. Hill '54 & '56).

(2015 Season): Appeared in 9 contests (Games 1, 6-9 and 11-14), grabbing 54 receptions for team-high 807 yards (14.9ypr) and 4 TDs.

- Inactive in Games 2-5 due to a hamstring injury, Game 10 due to groin/shoulder injuries and Game 15 due to a hamstring injury.

- Placed on Injured Reserve prior to Game 16.

- Had 7 games in 2015 where he was perfect on field goals with at least 3 attempts in a game (Games 1-2, 4, 6, 9-10), a new franchise record breaking his old mark of 5 such games in 2006, and was 1 away from Al Del Greco's NFL mark of 8 in 1998 with TEN.
- Added 1 special teams tackle.
- Named a team captain.
- **2015 NFL Ranks:** Tied-for-2nd in field goals made and tied-for-8th in the NFL among kickers in points.
