DOLPHINS PLAYERS SIGNED AFTER TRAINING CAMP

September 4, 2011

The Miami Dolphins have claimed tight end Will Yeatman off waivers and released defensive lineman Frank Kearse, it was announced on September 4, 2011.

The 6-5, 268 pound Yeatman originally signed with the New England Patriots on July 27, 2011 as an undrafted free agent. He was released by New England at the end of the preseason on September 3, 2011. Yeatman was a two-sport standout at Notre Dame (2006-08) and Maryland (2009-10) in football and lacrosse. He played in all 11 games for Maryland as a senior in 2010, starting three times and finishing the season with 13 receptions for 134 yards and one touchdown. Born April 10, 1988 in Naples, Italy, Yeatman attended Rancho Bernardo High School in San Diego, CA where he was a four-time letter winner in lacrosse and a three-time letter winner in football.

September 5, 2011

The Miami Dolphins signed tight end Dante Rosario and guard/center Ryan Cook, released linebacker A.J. Edds and terminated the contract of center/guard Joe Berger, it was announced on September 5, 2011.

The 6-4, 250 pound Rosario joins Miami after spending the 2011 training camp with the Denver Broncos. Prior to Denver, he spent the first four years of his career (2007-10) with the Carolina Panthers. A fifth-round selection (155th overall) by Carolina in the 2007 NFL Draft, Rosario played in 62 games, with 22 starts for the Panthers and totaled 82 receptions for 894 yards (10.9 avg.) with four touchdowns.

Rosario played in 47 games in four seasons at the University of Oregon, starting 27 and totaled 94 receptions for 1,003 yards (10.7 avg.) and 11 touchdowns and added 27 rushes for 84 yards (3.1 avg.) with two touchdowns. He also established a school record for receptions by a tight end after hauling in 42 passes for 426 yards (10.1 avg.) with one touchdown as a senior. Born, October 25, 1984, in Beaverton, Oregon, Rosario attended Dayton (OR) High School, where he was named the 2002 Oregon 2A State Defensive Player of the Year in addition to earning first-team all-state honors on both sides of the ball as a senior.

The 6-6, 328 pound Cook joins Miami after spending the last five seasons (2006-10) with the Minnesota Vikings. In his career, Cook has played in 70 games with 40 starts. Cook started at right tackle, right guard and center during his Vikings career. He was originally selected by Minnesota in the second round (51st overall) of the 2006 NFL Draft. Cook was a former walk-on at the University of New Mexico that went on to be a first-team All-Mountain West choice in his final three seasons. He played in 49 career games, starting the final 44 of his career in college. Born May 8, 1983 in Albuquerque, New Mexico, Cook was a second team All-State selection and 1st-team All-City choice as a senior and 2nd-team All-City selection as a junior at Cibola High (Albuquerque, NM).

THE COACHES

Tony Sparano became the eighth head coach in Dolphins history on January 16, 2008. He is in his 12th season in the NFL and his 27th year in the coaching profession. In his first year as the Dolphins' head coach in 2008, Sparano guided the team to a single season turnaround matched just once in NFL history. Taking over a 1-15 squad from a year earlier, he led the Dolphins to an 11-5 record and the AFC East title. His ten-game improvement has been achieved only one other time in league annals, in 1999 when the Indianapolis Colts went from 3-13 to 13-3. Before leading the Dolphins, he spent five seasons (2003-07) on the staff of the Dallas Cowboys, during which time the team made three playoff appearances. He tutored the Cowboys' offensive line the last three years while also holding the title of assistant head coach the past two seasons. He coached the team's tight ends his first two seasons in Dallas. Prior to joining the Cowboys, Sparano had NFL stops in Cleveland (1999-2000), Washington (2001) and Jacksonville (2002). Sparano was a four-year letterman as a center at the University of New Haven, where he earned his degree in criminal law. He began his coaching career at his alma mater in 1984 before moving on to Boston University as offensive coordinator in 1989. He returned to New Haven as the school's head coach in 1994, and manned that spot for the next five years.

Bill Belichick is in his 37th season as an NFL coach (17 of which have been as a head coach), and has spent his most recent 12 seasons as head coach of the Patriots. He has amassed a career regular season record of 162-94 (126-50 with the Patriots), including a 15-6 (14-5 with the Patriots) record in the playoffs and has three Super Bowl victories (2001, 2003, and 2004), becoming the only head coach in NFL history to win three Super Bowl championships in a four-year span. With the Patriots, Belichick has been named AP Coach of the Year three times in his career (2003, 2007, 2010). Before joining the Patriots in 2000, Belichick was the assistant head coach/secondary coach for the New York Jets for three seasons (1997-1999), and had the responsibility of calling defensive plays. He also spent one year with the Patriots prior to his current tenure in 1996, again serving as assistant coach/secondary coach for the team that went to Super Bowl XXXI. His first experience as an NFL head coach came from 1991-1995 when he was at the helm of the Cleveland Browns. In 1979, Belichick was with the New York Giants as a defensive assistant and special teams coach, starting his 12-year tenure with the team. After the 1980 campaign, he drew the added responsibility of coaching the Giants linebackers. While continuing to coach the linebackers, in 1983 his role with the defensive unit increased. He was named defensive coordinator in 1985, a position he held for the next six seasons. Before his run with the giants, Belichick was an assistant special teams coach with the Denver Broncos in 1978, and the Detroit Lions in 1976 and 1977 and at the age of 23 was special assistant to Baltimore Colts head coach Ted Marchibroda in 1975. Belichick lettered in football at Wesleyan University where he played center and tight end.

Dolphins with Patriots/New England area ties: OL Marc Colombo is from Bridgewater, Massachusetts and attended Bridgewater-Raynham Regional High School and Boston College...TE Jeron Mastrud was briefly on the Patriots practice squad in 2010.

Patriots with Dolphins/Miami area ties: CB Darius Butler attended Coral Spring Charter and was the first player from the school to sign a national letter of intent...His uncle Gene Atkins played for the Miami Dolphins.... Patriots WR Wes Welker was a member of the Dolphins during the 2004, 2005, and 2006 seasons...DL Vince Wilfork attended Santaluces (Lantana, Fla.) High and played three years at the University of Miami (2001-2003)... Patriot LB Rob Ninkovich was a member of the Dolphins (2007-08)...WR Chad Ochocino was born in Miami, FL and attend Miami Beach High School (Miami Beach, FL).

Coaching/Front office ties: Dolphins defensive backs coach Todd Bowles was a defensive backs coach in Cleveland when Patriots CB Leigh Bodden broke into the NFL with the Browns in 2003. Bowles

would coach Bodden for two seasons before leaving Cleveland following the 2004 season... Pass rush coach Bryan Cox played for the New England Patriots for one season in 2001 where he started seven games for them, finishing the season with 34 tackles...Coach Cox also played alongside Patriots DE Shaun Ellis for one season (2000), when Ellis was a rookie...Coach Cox also coached Ellis for three seasons (2006-08)...Offensive coordinator Brian Daboll began his coaching career in 2000 as a defensive assistant for the Patriots before being promoted to wide receivers coach where he held the position for five seasons in (2002-2006) and won three super bowls with the team (2001, 2003, 2004) and saw WR Deion Branch win super bowl MVP in 2004... Dolphins Director of College Scouting Chris Grier is a 1994 graduate of the University of Massachusetts-Amherst where he played football for two years before injuries ended his career. Dolphins Director of College Scouting Chris Grier is the son of Bobby Grier, the former Vice President-Player Personnel with the New England Patriots who currently is the Associate Pro Personnel Director with the Houston Texans. Dolphins Player Personnel Administrator Chris Shea was an assistant coach at Belmont (Mass.) High School in 1991. Additionally, Chris Shea is a native of Belmont, Mass. And was a varsity lineman at Belmont High School... special teams coach Scott O'Brien spent two seasons (2005-06) with the Miami Dolphins as coordinator of football operations/assistant to then Head Coach Nick Saban. In 2007, Patriots TE Coach Brian Ferentz played alongside RB Reggie Bush in New Orleans for a brief period. Patriots Defensive Assistant Coach Brian Flores and OL Marc Colombo were teammates at Boston College for three seasons (1999-2001). Patriots Offensive Assistant George Godsey and WR Brandon Marshall were together at the University of Central Florida (UCF). Godsey was Running Backs Coach (2009-10) and Quarterbacks Coach (2005-08) during Godsey's tenure. TE Coach Dan Campbell and Patriots CB Leigh Bodden were teammates in Detroit (2008).

Pro ties: RB Reggie Bush and LB Rob Ninkovich were teammates in New Orleans on two separate occasions (2006, 2008). In 2008, LB Ikaika Alama-Francis and CB Leigh Bodden were teammates in Detroit. DT Tony McDaniel and G Dan Connolly were teammates in Jacksonville (2006). DE Randy Starks and DT Albert Haynesworth were teammates in Tennessee for four seasons (2004-07). Last season, LB Jason Taylor, DE Shaun Ellis, DB James Ihedigbo, and RB Danny Woodhead were teammates in New York (Jets). In 2008, Ellis, Ihedigbo, and Woodhead were also teammates with LB Jason Trusnik, LS James Dearth, and OL Nate Garner in New York. Taylor and DE Andre Carter were teammates in Washington for one season (2008). In 2009, Trusnik and DB Bret Lockett were teammates in Cleveland. Last season, Dearth and LB Kevin Burnett were teammates in San Diego.

College/hometown ties: Patriots CB Leigh Bodden and Dolphins LB Cameron Wake both hail from Hyattsville, MD... Dolphins punter Brandon Fields and Patriots QB Brian Hoyer were teammates at Michigan State from 2004-2007... Patriots G Logan Mankins and Dolphins S Tyrone Culver were teammates for the Bulldogs of Fresno State (2002-2004)... S Tyrone Culver also patrolled the defensive backfield at Fresno State with Patriots S James Sanders (2002-2005) and was teammates with C Ryan Wendell for two seasons (2004-2005)...C Mike Pouncey and Patriots DE Jermaine Cunningham, TE Aaron Hernandez and LB Brandon Spikes were teammates at the University of Florida (2007-2009) and all a part of the 2009 national championship team...OL John Jerry was teammates with Patriots RB BenJarvus Green-Ellis during his entire career at Ole Miss (2006-2007)...LB Kevin Burnett and Patriots DT Albert Haynesworth played together at the University of Tennessee for two seasons (2000-2001)...OT Marc Colombo and Patriots C Dan Koppen started on the same offensive line at Boston College for two seasons, both earning All Big-East honors their senior year (2000-2001)...OL Nate Garner was teammates at Arkansas with Patriots QB Ryan Mallett for the 2008 season, the year Mallett transferred from Michigan...Both LB Kevin Burnett and DT Tony McDaniel were teammates with Patriots LB Jerrod Mayo the year he redshirted at Tennessee (2004...Dolphins DL Ryan Baker and Patriots OLB Rob Ninkovich played together at Purdue for two seasons (2004-2005)... Dolphins QB Matt Moore and Patriots WR Matt Slater played together at UCLA for the 2003 season before Moore transferred...Slater also played his entire career for the Bruins under Dolphins quarterback coach Karl Dorrell while he was head coach for UCLA (2003-2007)...Dolphins LB AJ Edds and Patriots LB Jeff Tarpinian were a part of the same linebacker core with the Iowa Hawkeyes for three seasons (2007-2009)...OL Vernon Carey and Patriots DT Vince Wilfork both played together at the University of Miami (2001-2003), both contributing to the 2001 national championship season.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN 2011

S Jeremiah Bell

- If Bell starts in every game in 2011, Bell would play in all 16 games for the fourth consecutive season.
- Bell is looking to garner 100 or more tackles for the fourth consecutive season. He notched a career-high 120 tackles in 2008, followed up with 113 in 2009 and 101 in 2010.
- With 3.5 sacks in 2011, Bell would break the team record of 3.0 sacks in a season by a defensive back. Bell had 3.0 sacks in 2005 and is tied with Liffort Hobley (1990), Jerry Wilson (1999) and Nate Jones (2008).

WR Davone Bess

- Bess had recorded 82 receptions on third-down with Miami. He needs 19 third-down receptions to tie Chris Chambers (101) for second all-time in team history. O.J. McDuffie holds the team record for most third-down receptions in team history with 152.
- With 91 catches, Bess will have notched 300 for his career. Bess had a career-high 79 receptions in 2010.
- Brandon Marshall (86) and Davone Bess (79) combined for the most receptions in team history with 165 catches in 2010. The duo looks to better this mark in 2011.

LB Kevin Burnett

With 88 career games, he needs to play in 12 games to have seen action in 100 career NFL games.

RB Reggie Bush

- Bush has 294 receptions and needs six for 300 in his career. Since he entered the NFL in 2006, no current runner has recorded more receptions.

T Marc Columbo

With 95 career NFL games, he needs to play in five games to have seen action in 100 career games.

Brian Hartline

- Led the team in average yards per catch with 14.3 yards per reception. He is the first player in team history to lead the Dolphins in yards per catch in their first two seasons (minimum 10 catches) with the team since 1999, when Oronde Gadsden led the team in average yards per reception 1998 with 14.9 and 16.7 in 1999. The last Dolphins player to lead the team in average yards per catch in three consecutive seasons was Jimmy Cefalo who had an 18.1 yard average in 1980, 21.8 yard average in 1981 and 20.9 average in 1982.

Chad Henne

- Has 6,246 career passing yards, good for fourth all time in team history. Needs 4,794 passing yards to tie Jay Fiedler (11,040) for third place in team history.
- Has 13 wins as a starting quarterback, good for sixth in team history. Henne needs one win to tie Don Strock (14) for fifth place in team history.
- Currently has a 61.1 completion percentage with the Dolphins, good for second in team history. Henne trails Chad Pennington (67.4) for highest all-time completion percentage in Dolphins history.

Brandon Marshall

- Looks to notch 1,000 receiving yards for the fourth consecutive season. At Denver, Marshall had 1,325 yards in 2007, 1,265 in 2008, 1,120 in Denver and 1,014 in his first season in Miami.
- If Marshall has over 1,000 receiving yards in 2011, he will be the first Dolphins player to have to consecutive 1,000 yard seasons since Irving Fryar who had 1,010 receiving yards in 1993 and 1,270 yards in 1994.
- Brandon Marshall (86) and Davone Bess (79) combined for the most receptions in team history with 165 catches in 2010. The duo looks to better this mark in 2011.

Cameron Wake

- Currently has 19.5 sacks in his first two seasons with the team, which is the second highest total in team history. Wake needs 7.0 sacks to tie Joey Porter for most sacks in his first three seasons with the Dolphins (Porter had 5.5 in 2007 and 17.5 in 2008, 7.0 sacks in 2009).

LB Jason Taylor

- When he plays in a game in 2011, it would mark his 13th season with the Dolphins. He would become the sixth player in team history to achieve that tenure mark.

- When he plays in a game in 2011, it would mark his third stint with the team, having played with Miami from 1997-2007, Washington in 2008, Miami in 2009, the N.Y. Jets in 2010 and Miami again in 2011. He would become the first player in team history to have been a member of the Dolphins' active roster on three different occasions with those broken up with time on the rosters of other NFL teams. The last player to appear in a game in three different stints with one franchise (by different stints, he played for other teams in between) was Jeremiah Trotter, who played for the Eagles for a third time in 2009.

- With 188 games played with the Dolphins, he needs to play in nine games to move past Bob Kuechenberg (196 games) into second place on the team's all-time most games played list.

- With 188 games played with the Dolphins, he needs to play in 12 games to join Dan Marino (242 games) as the only players to see action in 200 or more games with the Dolphins.

- With 184 career starts, he needs to start all 16 games to join Dan Marino as the only players to start in 200 or more games with the Dolphins.

- With 132.5 career sacks, can move as high as fifth place on the NFL's all-time sack list, breaking his tie with Leslie O'Neal and Lawrence Taylor and moving past Richard Dent and John Randle (sixth place with 138 sacks) and Michael Strahan (fifth place with 142 sacks).
