What is the Eagles Autism Foundation?

The Philadelphia Eagles have launched the Eagles Autism Foundation, a new endeavor that centralizes all of the Eagles' autism activities into one organization. Led by Philadelphia Eagles Chairman and CEO Jeffrey Lurie, the team's commitment to autism over the last two years has grown exponentially, raising more than \$7 million dollars since September of 2018.

Championed by Lurie, whose family has been personally touched by autism, the Eagles Autism Foundation sets out to drive scientific breakthroughs and establish Philadelphia as a major center for autism research and care. By providing critical resources, supporting scientific discoveries and helping to position Philadelphia as a base for autism research and care, the Eagles Autism Foundation is creating a major shift from awareness to action.

Who is this event for?

Eagles Huddle Up for Autism is designed specifically for kids and teens on the autism spectrum and their families.

What ages can attend?

All ages are welcome to attend.

Are there any incentive to fundraise?

If I signed up to fundraise do I automatically get tickets?

Through our VIP pre-sale you are automatically guaranteed up to six complimentary tickets for your family to attend Eagles Huddle Up for Autism if you register between the dates of *February 25th and March 3rd* and commit to fundraising \$250. Tickets will be emailed to you no later than one month prior to the event.

Fundraising

When is the fundraising deadline?

The deadline is Friday, May 1st, 2020 for everyone. For those a part of the VIP pre-sale your card will be charged on that date if you have not met your \$250 fundraising minimum.

Where is the event being held?

The event will take place at Lincoln Financial Field, 1 Lincoln Financial Field Way, Philadelphia, PA 19147.

Can I take public transportation to Lincoln Financial Field?

How much are tickets?

Tickets are \$5 per person and are required for every individual attending the event.

Does it cost money to park at the event?

No. K-lot will be open for free to all Huddle Up with Eagles Autism Challenge attendees. Fundraisers will have a separate parking lot and event entrance.

Will food be available for purchase?

Concession stands will be open and a variety of items will be available for purchase. Gluten-free food will also be available.

Will you postpone or cancel Huddle Up with Eagles Autism Challenge if it rains?

No. The event will go on rain or shine. Many of the activities will be held on the club level or service level of the stadium, which are both entirely closed and climate controlled.

Can I bring my dog?

Service dogs are the only permitted dogs in the stadium.

Is Lincoln Financial Field wheelchair accessible?

Will we get to see any Philadelphia Eagles players?

Yes. Eagles' players, cheerleaders and SWOOP will be on site.

Will we get to tour the field?

Yes, there will be self-guided tours of the field and locker room.

Where can I go if my child needs a break?

Quiet rooms will be available on all levels of Lincoln Financial Field open for Huddle Up with Eagles Autism Challenge. Please see event signage, maps, or event staff for the closest quiet room.

The full sensory room is also located on the Lower Suite Level. We ask that the sensory room is utilized as a break space and return to the event and activities when ready. Please see event signage, maps, or event staff for the closest quiet room.

Where can I find Eagles Autism Resources such as a visual schedule?

Download the Eagles Application in order to access content such as a visual schedule, social story, and map of the day of. The resources may help your child prepare in advance of the event as well of help navigate on the day of.

Can I bring a TSS or aide to assist my child?
