



# TOUCHDOWN FOR TEACHERS

## Program Description

This Spring, three educators will be honored for their outstanding service to their schools and communities. The public is invited to complete the (attached) form to nominate an educator to be considered for this honor.

Three (3) finalists ("Finalists") will be selected by a panel of community members and school officials, with the assistance of the Baltimore Ravens and M&T Bank staff (the "Panel"). Additionally, the Panel will select one (1) of the Finalists to be the winner ("Winner") of the following prizes:

- \$4,000 in grant funds, payable to their school or district to further their impact
- A school visit by a Ravens player, accompanied by Poe and Ravens Cheerleaders

The two remaining Finalists will receive the following prizes:

- \$1,000 in grant funds, payable to their school or district to further their impact

All nominees will receive a certificate of recognition from the Baltimore Ravens and M&T Bank.

## Selection Criteria\*

The Finalists and the Winner will be chosen by the Panel based on one or more of the following guidelines:

- Amount of involvement in the school and/or community (volunteering, coaching, etc)
- Degree of positive impact on the school and/or community
- Demonstrated commitment to education and the school and/or community

Educators are defined for this program as individuals directly involved in the instruction and education of students, including but not limited to: teachers, guidance counselors and teacher's aides. School and district administrators are not eligible to be nominated or to be recognized as Finalists, but are welcome to nominate educators for recognition. Employees and relatives of employees of the Baltimore Ravens or M&T Bank are also ineligible.
