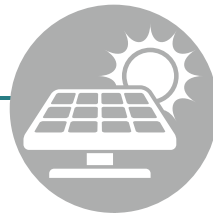


GREEN EFFORTS

The team's bio-digester, which decomposes pre-consumer food waste, can handle up to 330 pounds daily.

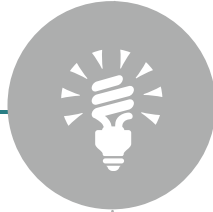

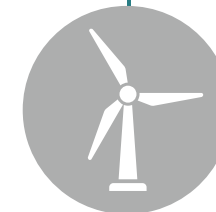

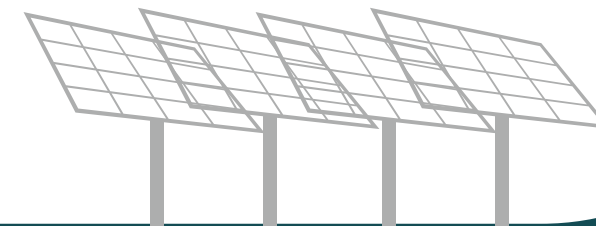
The Eagles recycle more than 850 tons of material each year, which is enough to fill 22 tractor trailers.
