2020 HIGHLIGHTS


- Found the end zone for a 19-yd. TD vs. Mia. (10/11), his 1st TD of the season and 10th of his career.
- Recorded a career-high 8 receptions for 81 yds. at Sea. (11/1).

GOLDMINE

- During the 2020 offseason, Bourne returned to his home state of Oregon to organize a meet and greet with fans and auction off raffles to benefit the Bourne Blessed Autism Foundation. "My uncles have autism and they are just happy about life. They used to watch me when I was younger and they just used to do everything I wanted as an athlete. They took me to go shoot hoops or go to the field," said Bourne. "Those two guys, I just love them to death so that is why we started it."

NFL players had the opportunity to participate in the NFL's annual My Cause, My Cleats campaign during Week 14 of the 2019 season. Bourne and his teammates represented their respective causes with custom-designed cleats in an effort to raise awareness and funding. Bourne chose the charity Autism Speaks and said, "I play for my uncles."

- In October of 2019, Bourne and his teammates spent time with fans and members of local Silicon Valley businesses to compete in a bowling tournament as the 49ers Foundation hosted the second annual 1st and Bowl Challenge. The funds raised at the event will support the charitable programs of the 49ers Foundation and benefit Bay Area youth.



BOURNE'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

 Bourne's heritage consists of being half Samoan and half African-American. He has a number of ancestral tattoos that begin on his left shoulder and stretch all the way down to his wrist. In 2013, after his senior season at Milwaukie Arts (Portland, OR) Academy, Bourne was honored when he was chosen to play in the Polynesian All-American Bowl in La Mirada, CA. The love for his heritage was instilled in him by his mom, Luisa, who he calls his 'Reason why.'

 Students at Bourne's high school, which is a charter school (Milwaukie Academy of the Arts), received special permission from the Oregon School Athletics Association (OSAA) to compete on Milwaukie High School athletics teams.

GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)

- In June of 2020, Bourne, through the Bourne Blessed Foundation, teamed up with the TAP Foundation to bring 100,000 pounds of fresh fruit and vegetables to East San Jose, one of the hardest hit areas affected by COVID-19 in Santa Clara County. Families received three boxes of food each by passing through a drive-thru system that was put in place to allow for social distancing. "We really wanted to provide the right nutrition because many people don't have access to food right now and money is tight. The main reason was to give healthy food to those in need."

2019

- Played in all 16 games and registered 30 receptions for 358 yards and a career-high 5 touchdowns. His 5 receptions also ranked tied 1st on the team (George Kittle - 5). Appeared in all 3 postseason games and tallied 6 receptions for 88 yards and 1 touchdown.
- Registered a 7-yard TD reception at Arizona (10/31), his 1st TD of the season.
- Recorded 4 receptions for 42 yards and 1 touchdown vs. Seattle (11/11), marking his 2nd TD of the season. Registered a reception TD in back-to-back games for the first time in his career. Also hauled in a two-point conversion pass from QB Jimmy Garoppolo.
- Registered 4 receptions for 31 yards and 1 touchdown vs. Arizona (11/17). Notched a TD reception in 3 consecutive games and was the first member of the 49ers to accomplish that feat since WR Dante Pettis [1 TD reception at Tampa Bay (11/25/18); 2 TD receptions at Seattle (12/2/18); 1 TD reception vs. Denver (12/9/18)].
- Registered 3 receptions for 18 yards and 2 touchdowns at New Orleans (12/8). His 2 touchdowns marked his first career game with 2-or-more reception TDs.
- On the final drive of the game vs. Los Angeles Rams (12/21), had a key 18-yard reception on 3rd-and-16 that helped set up the game-winning 33-yard field goal by Robbie Gould as time expired.
- Made his postseason debut vs. Minnesota (1/1/20 - NFC Divisional) and registered 3 receptions for 40 yards and 1 touchdown.

2018

- Registered career highs in games played (16), starts (8), receptions (42), receiving yards (487) and reception TDs (4).
- Registered his first career TD reception on a 4-yard pass from QB Jimmy Garoppolo vs. Detroit (9/16).
- In his first career start at Arizona (10/28), hauled in a career-high 7 receptions for a team-high 71 yards.
- Registered 5 receptions for 59 yards and 1 touchdown, his 4th of the season, at Los Angeles Rams (12/30).

2017

- Played in 11 games and tallied 16 receptions for 257 yards.
- Registered 4 receptions for a career-high 85 yards vs. Tennessee (12/17). Also tallied a career-long 54-yard reception.

Appeared in 53 games (32 starts) and totaled 211 receptions for 3,130 yards and 27 touchdowns during his four-year career at Eastern Washington. As a senior, earned Second-Team All-Big Sky honors after starting all 13 games and registering 79 receptions for 1,201 yards and 7 touchdowns. In 2015, appeared in 11 games (10 starts) and recorded 73 receptions for 998 yards and 8 touchdowns to earn Second-Team All-Big Sky honors. As a sophomore, appeared in all 14 games (9 starts) and earned All-Big Sky Honorable Mention honors after totaling 52 receptions for 814 yards and 10 touchdowns. Saw action in 14 games as a freshman in 2013 and notched 7 receptions for 117 yards and 2 touchdowns.
