GOLDMINE

- Edwards grew up in Southfield, Michigan, a city located outside of Detroit, and about 20 miles from the Canadian border. After finishing his collegiate career at Idaho, Edwards spent three seasons in the CFL. The familiar scenery was an asset when it came to the transition of playing football and living in a different country. "The transition to Canada was easier than I expected," said Edwards. "I definitely enjoyed my time playing and living there."
- As a senior at Idaho, Edwards was known for his speed and versatility. After a standout junior season at safety, Edwards' coach at the time, Paul Petrino, decided to move him to linebacker to increase the speed at the position. Edwards made an impression on his teammates, with former teammate Marc Millan saying, "He's a safety, so he's fast obviously, he's smart. He's definitely one of the smartest guys we have on our defense. He just clicks all the time. He understands the defense and he loves to hit."

Started all 12 games as a senior in 2015, recording 62 tackles, 8.0 TFLs, 1 INT, 1 FF, 1 FR and 4 PDs. Played in 6 games as a junior in 2014, where he recorded 14 tackles, 2 INTs and 1.0 TFL. Transferred to Idaho from Butte (CA) College where he totaled 55 tackles, 1 INT and 1 FR as a sophomore. Spent his freshman season at Grand Rapids (MI) Community College where he registered 5 tackles, 2 INTs and 1 PD in 4 games.
