2020 HIGHLIGHTS

- Completed 26 of 39 passes for 316 yds. and 3 TDs vs. Buf. (12/7), his 4th career 300-yd. passing game. His 3 passing TDs are also tied for a career-best.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Threw for over 220 yds. in each of his 9 career starts, tying the franchise record set by QB Joe Montana (9 starts from 12/9/85 to 12/7/86) for the most consecutive starts throwing for 220 yds.-or-more.
- His 4,405 passing yds. in his 1st 16 career starts are the 2nd-most by a QB in the Super Bowl Era.

GOLDMINE

- The 49ers hosted the third annual Crucial Catch Fashion Show presented by Dignity Health in October of 2019, featuring cancer warriors representing all cancers as they modeled apparel donated by Levi's. Mullens and his teammates were paired with each of the warriors to share their stories of strength and courage with the audience and walk the runway.
- Prior to Week 2's match-up in Cincinnati during the 2019 season, the 49ers spent time in Youngstown, OH, where they participated in the Community Blitz. Mullens and some of his teammates joined the students at Williamson Elementary School to talk about inclusion and anti-bullying. The players spoke at an assembly before helping the kids write compliment cards and discuss how to be kind to one another.
- The 49ers and their families hosted 450 underserved boys and girls from the Bay Area for the first-ever 49ers Hope for the Holidays event. Each child had a once-in-a-lifetime experience traveling through Levi's Stadium and left with a brand new bike, helmet, lock, haircut, shoes, toys, glasses, backpack, dinner and more.



- TE George Kittle partnered with the Jessie Rees Foundation to pass out JoyJars filled with toys and games at a local children's hospital. Mullens attended the event and was joined by several of his teammates including, TE Garrett Celek, TE Ross Dwelley, TE Daniel Helm and LB Fred Warner who helped him spread holiday cheer and lift the spirits of everyone they met.



GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)

- In partnership with the One Love Foundation, Mullens, his 49ers teammates and their significant others participated in a film-based workshop with local high school students about healthy and unhealthy relationships. The group watched a film together, and thereafter, held group discussions about the implications of the relationship behaviors depicted in the film. The One Love Foundation believes that love is a skill we can work on, and focuses on three main elements to convey their message: content, conversation and community action.



- Mullens and his teammates surprised guests of the CityTeam Men's Program and House of Grace in November of 2018, at Levi's Stadium. The group believed they were just taking a tour of the stadium, but they were in fact joining the 49ers players for a night full of exciting events. The guests received a makeover and haircut, selected a new outfit from Dockers, snapped a new headshot and then shared a Thanksgiving dinner with the 49ers players.

- Started all 8 games he appeared in and completed 176 of 274 atts. for 2,277 yds. and 13 TDs for a QB rating of 90.8.
- In his NFL debut vs. Oak. (11/1), completed 16 of 22 atts. (72.7 pct.) for 262 yds., 3 TDs and QB rating of 151.9. Became the first player, making his NFL debut with the 49ers, to throw for 2-or-more TDs in that game.
- With 3 TD passes against the Raiders, Mullens tied the franchise record for the most TD passes by a player in his first start with the 49ers [QB Tim Rattay vs. StL (11/2/03); QB Ty Detmer vs. Car. (11/8/98); QB Matt Cavanaugh at Phi. (9/23/84)]. Also set the franchise record for highest QB rating (min. 10 atts.) in his first start with the team (151.9) and ranks 3rd for the most passing yds. (262).

- Became the first member of the 49ers to pass for 3-or-more TDs in a game since Colin Kaepernick on 11/27/16 at Mia. (3 TD passes).
- Mullens joined Hall of Famers Fran Tarkenton (1961) and Jim Kelly (1986) as the only players in NFL history to throw for 250-or-more yds., 3-or-more TDs and 0 INTs in their NFL debut.
- His QB rating of 151.9 against the Raiders was the 2nd-highest by a QB in his NFL debut since 1973 (min. 15 atts.).

- Completed 30 of 48 passes for a career-high 414 yds. and 2 TDs at Sea. (12/2). His 414 passing yds. on the day were the most by a 49ers QB since QB Tim Rattay registered 417 passing yds. vs. Arz. (10/10/04). He became the the first 49ers QB to throw for 400-or-more yds. in a single game since QB Colin Kaepernick in 2013 [412 yds. vs. GB (9/8/13)].
- Converted 20 of 33 atts. for 332 yds., 2 TDs and a QB rating of 102.1 vs. Den. (12/9). With 332 passing yds., became the first 49ers QB to throw for 300-or-more yds. in consecutive games [30 of 48 for 414 yds. and 2 TDs at Sea. (12/2/18)] since QB Jimmy Garoppolo in 2017 [20 of 33 for 334 yds. and 1 TD at Hou. (12/10/17) and 31 of 43 for 381 yds. and 1 TD vs. Ten. (12/17/18)].

2018 (CONTINUED)

- With 313 passing yds. versus the Broncos, became the first undrafted 49ers QB to throw for 300-or-more yds. in consecutive games since QB Jeff Garcia accomplished the feat in three straight games from 12/3/00-12/17/00. Also, joins Broncos QB Case Keenum (10/7/18-10/14/18) as the only undrafted QBs to throw for 300-or-more yds. in consecutive weeks since the start of the 2017 season.
- Completed 20 of 29 atts. for 275 yds., 1 TD and a QB rating of 110.6 vs. Sea. (12/16). In two games against the Seahawks this season, Mullens threw for 689 yds. [414 yds. at Sea. (12/2/18)], the most passing yds. in a single season against Seattle since their franchise began in 1976.
- Completed 23 of 33 atts. for 282 yds. and 3 TDs at LAR (12/30). With 282 passing yds., became the first 49ers QB to register 220-or-more passing yds. in eight-consecutive games since QB Joe Montana accomplished the feat in nine-consecutive games from 12/9/85 to 12/7/86.

COLLEGE

In four seasons at Southern Mississippi (2013-16), played in 44 games (41 starts) and completed 928 of 1,546 atts. for 11,994 yds. and 87 TDs. In 2016, made 11 starts and completed 243 of 384 atts., for 3,272 yds. and 24 TDs, averaging 297.5 passing yds. per game. Started all 14 games as a junior in 2015, setting single-season school records for passing yds. (4,476) and TD passes (38) as the Golden Eagles finished with more than 7,000 yds. of offense for the first time in school history. In 2014, started 10 games and completed 218 of 365 atts. for 2,470 passing yds. and 12 TDs. As a freshman in 2013, appeared in 9 games (6 starts) and threw for 1,776 yds. and 13 TDs while earning Conference USA All-Freshman honors.

- Attended Spain Park (Birmingham, AL) HS, where he had 8,605 career passing yds., finishing his high school career with the 7th-most passing yds. in AHSAA history, to go along with 40 passing TDs.
