2020 HIGHLIGHTS

- Intercepted Rams QB Jared Goff on 4th-and-goal in the 3rd Qtr. vs. LAR (10/18), marking his 1st INT of the season and his first since 9/11/16 as a member of the San Diego Chargers.
- Intercepted Washington Football Team QB Alex Smith late in the 1st half vs. Was. (12/13), marking his 2nd INT of the season and 7th of his career. His 2 INTs this season are the most in a season by him since 2015 (3 INTs).

GOLDMINE

 Throughout his NFL career, Verrett has been involved in multiple community outreach initiatives, looking to positively impact the public. One that he frequently partakes in is the Play 60 program, which encourages kids to spend at least 60 minutes a day outside. During the events, players engage with young fans through drills, scrimmages, and more. As a professional football player, Verrett knows the importance of stay-



ing active and passes that wisdom on when he can. "Follow your heart, keep your dreams alive," he said. "That was something I did when I was younger. I just kept my dream alive, all about football. Making sure I took care of my body. All the right things to keep me going."

- Marvel's blockbuster Black Panther is a favorite of many, including cornerback Jason Verrett. When the film debuted in February of 2017, Verrett took 350 local students from Rodriguez High School to a screening. Verrett, a 2009 graduate of the school, acted like a superhero himself, hoping to uplift the kids who might not have been able to afford to see the film otherwise. The movie, which is set in Oakland and a fictional country in Africa called Wakanda, is highlighted by an African superhero and sports a primarily African-American cast. "I just think it's great. It's Marvel, first of all, plus it's so great for young kids to be able to have a superhero they admire and draw inspiration from," Verrett said.
- In December of 2018, Verrett spent his time with the Vacaville Neighborhood Boys and Girls Club, providing the kids with 50 winter coats, gift cards, and a bounty of toys. "Our Christmas party brings together the best in our community, especially the kids. They never know what gifts they will receive, or if they will even receive a gift," said Anna Eaton, executive director of the club. "[they] all were especially warmed to know that a community member thought of them."

In order to break the record, his attempt needed to be captured on video with a clear shot of each high five. Three hundred fans lined up to help him



with the feat. Reaching every hand in 40 seconds, Verrett ran too quickly for the camera to follow him on a golf cart. Sadly, Verrett had to return to his workout and wasn't able to officially beat the previous record.

COLLEGE

Played three seasons (2011-13) at Texas Christian after spending the 2010 season at Santa Rosa (CA) Junior College. Appeared in 37 games (34 starts) for the Horned Frogs, finishing with 160 tackles, 10 TFLs, 35 PDs and 9 INTs. As a senior in 2013, was named Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Year and First-Team All-Big 12 in addition to Associated Press Second-Team All-America honors. Made 11 starts and finished with 39 tackles, 14 PDs, 3.5 TFLs, 2 INTs, 1.0 sack and 1 FF. In 2012, started 13 games and tied for the most INTs in the Big 12 (6) to go along with a Big 12-high 22 PDs and was named Third-Team All-America by the AP. As a sophomore, appeared in 13 games (10 start), finished with 58 tackles, 4 PDs, 1.5 TFLs and 1 INT and earned Honorable Mention All-Mountain West honors following his freshman season at Santa Rosa Junior College. At SRJC, earned First-Team All-NorCal and California Community College Athletic Association All-State honors after picking up 44 tackles, 4 INTs and 6 PDs.
