2020 HIGHLIGHTS

- Registered 12 carries for 15 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 3 recpts. for 54 yds. and 1 TD at NYG (9/27). It marked the first time he recorded at least 1 rushing TD and 1 rec. TD in the same game.
- Rushed for a career-high 112 yds. and a career-high 3 TDs on 17 carries (6.6 avg.) at NE (10/25). It marked his first career 100-yd. game.
- His 3 rushing TDs were the most by a 49ers RB on the road since RB Roger Craig registered 3 rushing TDs at LAR (10/16/88).
- Registered 11 carries for 31 yds. and a 1-yd. TD run vs. Was. (12/13).
- Registered 16 carries for 60 yds. and a 1-yd. TD run at Dal. (12/20).
- Registered 22 carries for a career-high 183 yds. at Arz. (12/26), marking his 2nd 100-yd. rushing game of the season. He also added 1 recpt. for a 21-yd. TD. With 1 TD vs. Was. (12/13/20) and 1 TD at Dal. (12/20/20), has scored at least 1 TD in 3 consecutive games for the 1st time in his career.
- His 183 rushing yds. were the most by a member of the 49ers in a single game since RB Carlos Hyde registered 193 rushing yds. vs. NYJ (12/11/16) and the 5th-most by a member of the 49ers since 2000.

WILSON'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Has been drumming since he was two years old. His father, Wilson Sr., sang in a gospel group and Wilson backed him up on the drums.
- Grew up in Elkhart, TX, roughly 10 miles from the hometown of RB Adrian Peterson. Wilson and his dad, Jeff Wilson Sr., regularly attended Peterson's high school games, breaking down his play to emulate his style in practice.

GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)

- When he was 13 years of age, Wilson moved to Elkhart, TX, to live with his father, Jeff Sr. Wilson and his father used the rural surroundings to their advantage, creating a training program using the equipment they already owned. "We'd go old school," said Wilson. "We'd just hook up a tractor tire to a rope in the front yard, put a little loop around it and now I'm running with the tire. That was kind of like our little sled." The two of them would get up early every day and train, running long distances and catching passes in the yard. "That's why I love the country. There's a lot of things you can do with a lot of different things. You can have fun with it." When his little sister moved out of the house, Wilson and his dad then converted her room into a makeshift gym. "We had the cement weights," Wilson said. "It was basically a rock. If you dropped it on the ground, it would crack. We didn't have a lot of big weights, so we would have, like, three or four 25s on the bar and two to four 10s. We used to make up stuff. That was the beauty of it."

GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)

- NFL players had the opportunity to participate in the NFL's annual My Cause, My Cleats campaign during Week 14 of the 2019 season. Wilson and his teammates represented their respective causes with custom-designed cleats in an effort to raise awareness and funding. Wilson represented MADD, saying, "I play for awareness against drunk driving."

2019

- Played in 10 games and registered 27 carries for 105 yds. and a single-season career-high 4 TDs. Also added 3 repts. for 34 yds. and 1 TD. Also appeared in 1 postseason game and had 1 reept. for 20 yds.
- Registered 10 carries for 34 yds. and 2 TDs at Cin. (9/15). Became the first member of the 49ers to register 2-or-more rushing TDs in a single game since RB Carlos Hyde at LAR (12/31/17 - 2 TDs).
- Recorded 8 carries for 18 yds. and 2 TDs vs. Pit. (9/22). Became the first member of the 49ers with at least 2 rushing TDs in consecutive games since RB Frank Gore in Weeks 7-8 of the 2013 season.
- On his only offensive snap of the game vs. Arz. (11/17), he registered a game-winning 25-yd. TD reept. to give the 49ers the lead with 0:31 left in the game. It marked his first game-winning TD and first TD reept. of his career.

2018

- After being promoted to the active roster on 11/24, carried the ball 66 times for 266 yds. (4.0 avg.). Added 12 repts. for 98 rec. yds.
- Registered 15 carries for 61 yds. on the ground along with 8 repts. for 73 yds. at Sea. (12/2). His 8 repts. are the most by a 49ers RB since RB Carlos Hyde registered 9 repts. vs. Arz. (11/5/17).
- Rushed for a career-high 90 yds. on 23 atts. vs. Den. (12/9). His 23 atts. were the most by a 49ers RB since 9/21/17 (RB Carlos Hyde - 25 atts. for 84 yds. and 2 TDs vs. LAR)

COLLEGE

Appeared in 41 games (29 starts) during his four-year career at North Texas. Rushed for 3,205 yds. and 32 TDs on 562 atts., while adding 70 repts. for 527 yds. and 2 TDs. He finished his career ranked 3rd in rushing TDs (32) and 4th in rushing yds. (3,205) in school history. Started all 11 games in which he appeared as a senior and notched 188 carries for 1,215 yds. and 16 TDs. Also had 24 repts. for 168 yds. In 2016, played in 11 games (10 starts) and recorded 169 carries for 936 yds. and 14 TDs while adding 29 repts. for 247 yds. and 1 TD. As a sophomore, played in 10 games (7 starts) and rushed for 830 yds. and 1 TD on 155 atts. Also notched 12 repts. for 71 yds. In 2014, had 50 carries for 224 yds. and 1 TD while adding 5 repts. for 41 yds. and 1 TD.
