## Registration

### Who is this event for?

Huddle Up for Autism is designed specifically for kids and teens on the autism spectrum and their families.

### What ages can attend?

All ages are welcome to attend.

### Are there any incentives to fundraise?

Definitely! Incentives include VIP event access and parking, player autographs, sweepstakes, food and drink vouchers and a ton of other cool prizes.

### If I signed up to fundraise do I automatically get tickets?

Through our VIP pre-sale you are automatically guaranteed up to six complimentary tickets for your family to attend Huddle Up for Autism if you register before or between the dates of *February 21<sup>st</sup> and February 26<sup>th</sup>* and commit to fundraising \$250. Tickets will be emailed to you no later than three weeks prior to the event. (Additional tickets may be purchased during the general sale starting Tuesday, February 28<sup>th</sup>).

### Can I purchase tickets on the day of the event?

Yes, tickets will be available for purchase on the day of the event.

### How much are tickets?

Tickets are \$10 per person and are required for every individual attending the event.

## Fundraising

### When is the fundraising deadline?

The fundraising deadline to receive incentives is Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023. If you participate in the VIP pre-sale your card will be charged on Sunday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> if you have not met your \$250 fundraising minimum.

## About the Event

### When is the event?

This year's Huddle Up for Autism will take place on Sunday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. All-Pro, MVP, Legend, and Hall of Fame fundraisers will have early access to the event beginning at 11:00 am. Attendees with general admission tickets will be able to enter the event beginning at 11:30 am. The event will conclude at 3:00 pm.



**Where is the event being held?**

The event will take place at Lincoln Financial Field, 1 Lincoln Financial Field Way, Philadelphia, PA 19147.

**Can I take public transportation to Lincoln Financial Field?**

**Does it cost money to park at the event?**

No. K-lot will be open for free to all Huddle Up for Autism attendees. Fundraisers will have a separate parking lot and event entrance.
