Ready to Rock!

Read through the text together, discussing it as necessary. Give learners time to color the picture of Rampage. If possible, look at the Rams Kids website together to learn more information.

Rampage Spends and Saves

If necessary, read aloud the math problems or lower the numbers in the problems to match grade level expectations. Encourage learners to show their work. Give time for learners to share their responses with partners, if possible.

Answers: 1. \$5; 2. \$13; 3. Rampage does not have enough money. He needs \$4 and only has \$3; 4. \$32

Rampage's Bus Tour

Work together with learners on this activity. If possible, use an online resource, such as Google Maps™, to find a map of Los Angeles. Younger children will likely need your help, but older learners might be able to work more independently. Be sure to review cardinal directions and the compass rose. You can also teach or review ordinal directions (southwest, southeast, northwest, and northeast).

Answers: 1. south; 2. the Pacific Ocean; 3. north (slightly northwest); 4. east; 5. Learner responses will vary based on where they live.

Discuss the activity ideas. Provide a variety of art supplies, such as construction paper, markers, scissors, and glue for learners to use. Give learners time to complete the activities.
