COACHING SHOUTOUTS

2017-present: (Buffalo Bills)

- Since arriving in Buffalo, Worswick has played an integral role in building a culture that has resulted in five playoff berths (2017, 2019-22), three division titles (2020-22) and a trip to the AFC Championship (2020).
- Promoted to the position of Director Team Administration prior to the 2022 season. In his current role, Worswick manages the football calendar and organizes the day-to-day operation of the team. He is the point of communication between the coaching staff and all supporting departments. Administers all practices and team functions. Assists the defense and special teams. Manages the coaching budget develops practice plans, builds practice schedules and oversees all coaching staff operations.

- For his first five seasons in Buffalo, Worswick assisted head coach Sean McDermott in the management of the coaching staff and assisted both the defense and special teams units.

- Was the football operations assistant for Carolina during the 2016 season. Helped coordinate coaching, scouting, equipment and the operations departments.
 - Worked as an intern during the 2014 and 2015 seasons for the Panthers in the equipment and football operations departments, assisting Carolina on their way to a 15-1 record and an appearance in Super Bowl 50.
