\$41 MILLION

The Chicago Bears and Bears Care have made over \$41 million dollars in City of Chicago charitable contributions since 2011.

In 2024, Chicago Park District's Junior Bear Football

program celebrated 75 years. Bears Care has supported this Chicago Parks Foundation legacy program with grant awards since its inception, including \$150K this past year, and the Bears continue to engage with program participants at 17 different parks throughout the city each year.

The Chicago Bears and Bears Care are committed to making significant community investments, including a minimum \$200K annually towards violence prevention and reduction efforts in partnership with City of Chicago programs such as Target Area Development Corporation in Auburn Gresham, Breakthrough Urban Ministries in Garfield Park, Enlace Chicago in Little Village and Metropolitan Peace Initiatives, amongst others.



\$2M

In 2024, Bears Care invested nearly **\$2** million dollars in City of Chicago communities in support of youth football, women's cancer initiatives, education and community revitalization in underserved areas.



5K

The Bears and Chicago Public Schools launched Chicago Public League Girls Flag Football in 2020 and in 2024, over 5,000 girls participated in 154 high school girls flag football teams in its first season as a varsity sport featuring 51 Chicago Public Schools.





In 2024, Bears players and alumni participated in nearly 250 appearances, including weekly visits throughout the season to Chicago Public Schools in partnership with Chicago based organization Youth Guidance to interact

with students who are part of the **Becoming A Man® (BAM®) and Working On Womanhood® (WOW)** programs, which serve **13,000 CPS students**.


