
SUPPORTING SMALL BUSINESS

TRUTH AND PURPOSE TOUR

The Truth and Purpose Tour, facilitated by the Institute for Common Power, is a profound learning journey through both the American South and the self-committed to fighting the assault on truth that is occurring in cities across the country. Aspects of our collective history that are too often dismissed, ignored, or denied, are explored- with central focus one the modern American Civil Rights Movement. Since 2023, the Seahawks have invested in taking 34 employees to go on the tour and have come back with life changing education through experience that can be passed on to our colleagues. Seahawks Legend, Michael Bennett and a local teacher, Lindsay Combs joined us in 2024.
