## GENERAL EVENT QUESTIONS

- **Why is Huddle up for Autism different this year?**
  - With the FIFA World Cup coming to Philadelphia, Lincoln Financial Field will be unavailable, so Huddle Up will go citywide in 2026. We're bringing the experience to multiple sensory-friendly locations across the city, adding new excitement and discovery for every family.
  
- **Where is the event being held this year?**
  - Huddle Up for Autism will be spread across four sensory-friendly locations this year. Lincoln Financial Field will **not** be available.

- **When and where can I purchase tickets?**

  - Ticket prices will vary by location, and guests may select multiple locations to attend. Please note that all ticket sales are managed directly by each location, not by the Philadelphia Eagles. Pricing is determined individually by each location and may differ.
- **Can I purchase tickets to attend all Huddle Up locations?**
  - Yes, you may attend as many locations as you'd like. Please note that tickets must be purchased for each location you'd like to attend.
- **What happens if tickets are sold out at the location I'd like to attend?**

- **Do I still need to purchase tickets if I am already a member at these locations?**

- **Who do I contact if I need a refund for my tickets?**

  - Yes, all fundraisers will need to purchase admission tickets for the location(s) they choose to attend.
- **If I am not a fundraiser, can I still attend this event?**
  - Yes, you can still purchase a ticket to attend Huddle Up for Autism at any location, even if you are not participating as a fundraiser.

## **EVENT DAY EXPERIENCE QUESTIONS**

- **Will parking be available at each of the locations?**
  - Parking will be available for purchase at each location. Please see each locations FAQ's for more information about directions and parking.
- **Will every location have the same Huddle Up experiences?**
  - Yes, every location will have the same Huddle Up activations which include resource tables, scheduled appearances from Eagles Entertainment teams, and sensory-friendly activities.
- **Will we get to see any Eagles Players, Swoop, or Cheerleaders at the locations?**
  - Yes. There will be scheduled appearances and opportunities to interact with Eagles players, Eagles Cheerleaders, and SWOOP! Players will **not** be announced until the day of the event.
    - Player interaction opportunities will be exclusively reserved for fundraisers who reach certain incentive levels, giving them an exclusive opportunity to meet and interact with the players. General attendees will **not** have player access.
