



The Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC), in conjunction with the Chicago Police Department, requires the following to ensure public safety during games/ concerts/events:

- **Taxis, TNPs, Pedicabs, and liveries must utilize drop-off points along the designated areas on shown the map.**
- **Drop-off/Pick-up and vehicle staging is prohibited between 16th and Cermak, Indiana to Calumet (and on Indiana, Roosevelt to Cermak).**
- **No pick-up or drop-off on DuSable Lake Shore Drive, including on-ramps, off-ramps, medians, turning lanes, shoulders, and emergency pull-off areas. (Strictly enforced)**
- **No vehicle stopping, standing, or parking in bus or bicycle lanes, fire lanes, sidewalk crossings, etc. (Strictly enforced)**
- **No pedicab shall be operated on the public ways in the area bounded on the north by Roosevelt Rd, on the west by Indiana Ave, on the south by 21st St (extended east to DuSable Lake Shore Drive), and on the east by Columbus Dr and DuSable Lake Shore Drive.**

*****Restrictions start 4 hours before the start of the game/concert/event, continue through the game/concert/event, and end 2 hours after the conclusion of the game/concert/event.**

*****OEMC traffic management directives and maps are subject to change by law enforcement authorities based on real-time conditions for the preservation of order and public safety.**
